DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION

## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the twenty-first year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia, entitled the *Road Traffic Act 1972, No. 8332*, it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on the day or respective days to be fixed by Proclamation or successive Proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.

And whereas by Proclamation dated 19 December 1972, Monday, 15 January 1973 was fixed as the day on which sections 1, 2, 3 (a), 3 (c), 4, 5 and 6 of the said *Road Traffic Act 1972 No. 8332* was to come into operation.

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Wednesday, 30 March 1983 as the day on which section 3 (b) of the said *Road Traffic Act 1972 No. 8332* shall come into operation.

Given under my hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid at Melbourne this twenty-ninth day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty-three and in the thirty-second year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
