PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

In pursuance of the provisions contained in section 71 (2) of the *Public Service Act 1974*, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates mentioned hereunder to be observed as Public Holidays or Public Half-Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified.

Public Half-Holidays from the Hour of Twelve noon:

WEDNESDAY, 13 APRIL 1983, within the Shire of Dundas.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twelfth day of April, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty-three, and in the thirty-second year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
