## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the thirty-second year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second Queen of Australia, entitled the State Insurance Office (Extension of Franchise) Act 1983, No. 9927, it is amongst other things enacted that the provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette.

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Thursday, 23 June 1983, as the day on which the provisions of the State Insurance Office (Extension of Franchise) Act 1983, No. 9927, shall come into operation.
