All supplies to be subject to the approval of the Officer duly authorised to accept delivery.

Where specifications are laid down, these must be strictly adhered to. All items not otherwise specified shall be in accordance with Australian Standard Specifications, where such exist, and, in their absence, with British Standard Specifications.

Where rates are based on a recognised List Price less a percentage discount, Contractors shall supply copies of Price Lists to Departments requiring same.

All electrical appliances and equipment must comply with the wiring regulations of the State Electricity Commission.

INSTALLATION, SERVICE AND WARRANTIES

The Contractor shall be responsible for the safe transport of the goods and any damage occasioned to the goods during transit or during handling on site shall be his responsibility and no goods will be accepted unless placed in position on site or rail free from any damage.

If, during the currency of the contract, a new model of any item for which the Contractor holds a contract becomes available, the Tender Board reserves the right to order the new model in lieu of the contract item. Variation in price, if any, must be approved by the Tender Board prior to issue of the order.

All equipment must be provided with approved guards over any working parts to prevent accidental bodily contact. These guards must comply with safety regulations of the Labour and Industry Act.
