Bank Holidays Act 1958

ALTERATION OF DAY APPOINTED AS A BANK
HOLIDAY

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria
and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia,
&c., &c., &c.

Whereas by section 4 of the *Bank Holidays Act 1958*,
the last Thursday in September shall be observed as a
bank holiday throughout the municipalities listed in the
Second Schedule to the said Act:

And whereas by Proclamation dated 13 September 1983
the Governor in Council—

- (1) declared that the said day shall not be a bank
holiday throughout the said municipalities; and
- (2) appointed Thursday, 22 September 1983 to be a
bank holiday throughout certain municipalities,
including the Shire of Bacchus Marsh, specified
in the Proclamation:

And whereas it is made to appear to the Governor in
Council expedient that Thursday, 22 September 1983
should not be a bank holiday in the Shire of Bacchus
Marsh.

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria,
in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice
of the Executive Council of the said State, and in
pursuance of the powers conferred by sections 5 and 7
of the *Bank Holidays Act 1958*, do by this my Proclama-
tion—

- (1) declare that Thursday, 22 September 1983 shall
not be a bank holiday throughout the Shire of
Bacchus Marsh; and
- (2) appoint Monday, 19 September 1983 to be a bank
holiday throughout the Shire of Bacchus Marsh.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of
Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this fifteenth
day of September, in the year of our Lord One
thousand nine hundred and eighty-three, and in
the thirty-second year of the reign of Her Majesty
Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
