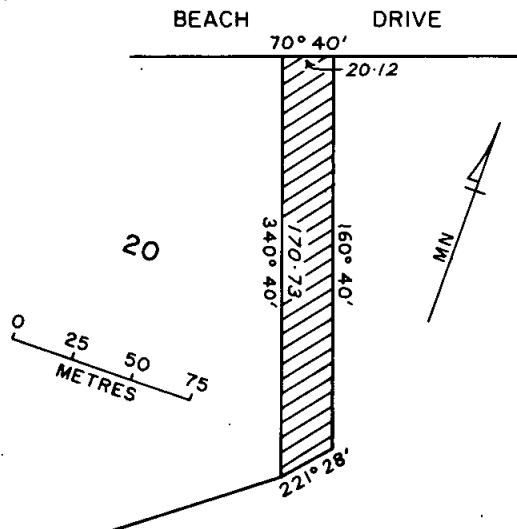

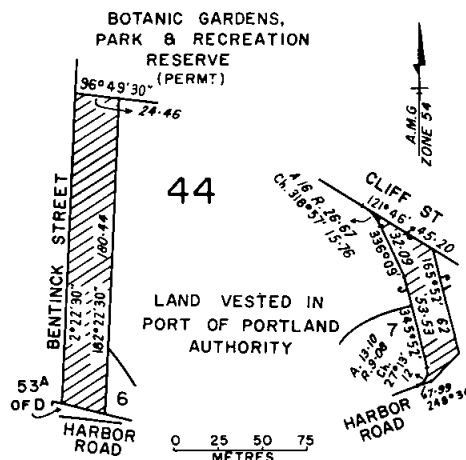

#### VETERINARY SURGEONS ACT 1958

(As Amended)

The Veterinary Board of Victoria on Tuesday, 13 December 1983, conducted an Inquiry in respect to charges of conduct discreditable to a veterinary surgeon against Dr. John Alexander Cooper, a registered veterinary surgeon of 167 Mount Dandenong Road, Croydon, Victoria, in that—

(1) He did during or about the months of July and August 1983 supply the drug Albipen to a lay person recklessly or knowing or suspecting that such drug would or might be administered by a lay person.

(2) He did during or about the months of July and August 1983 supply an uncompleted certificate of vaccination bearing his signature to a lay person recklessly or knowing or suspecting that such certificate of vaccination would be completed by a lay person.

In respect of item (1) the Board found that the said Dr. Cooper did supply the drug Albipen as charged; however the Board considered the matter to be one within the accepted bounds of normal veterinary practice and imposed no penalty.

In respect of item (2) the Board found the said Dr. Cooper guilty of the charge and ordered him to pay within 90 days a fine of \$500.00 and the sum of \$1 250.00 towards the costs of the Inquiry.

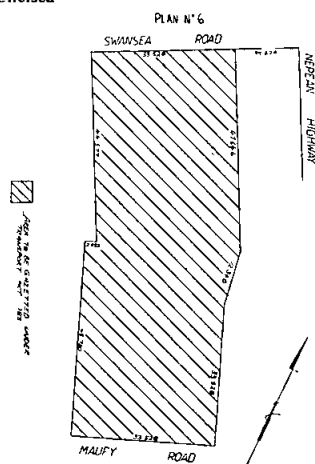

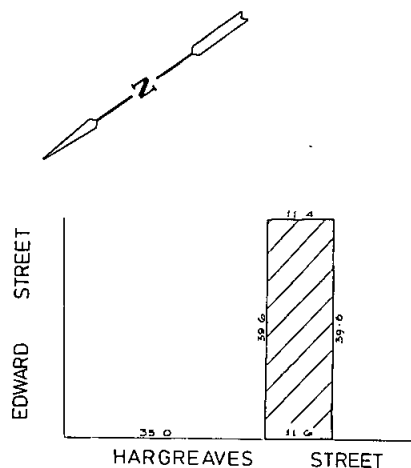


PLAN 'B'

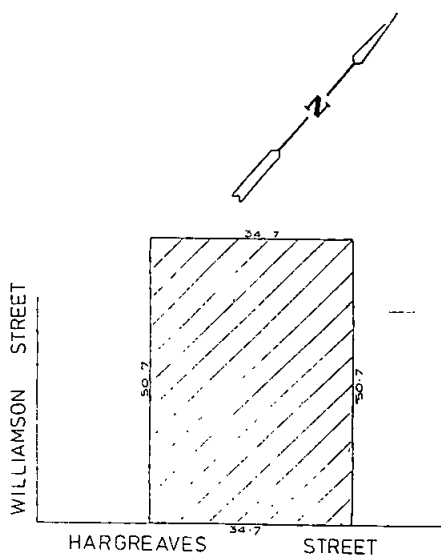

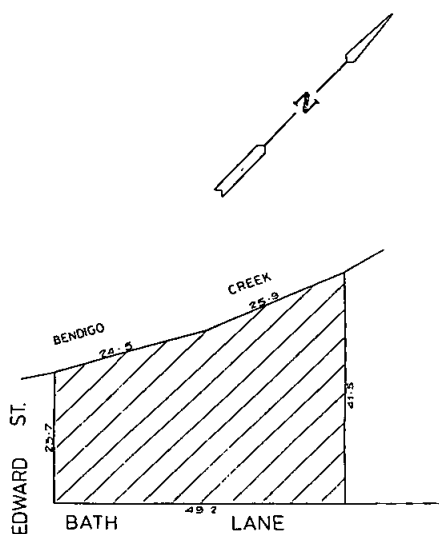
