### **PROCLAMATION**

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by the Bank Holidays Act 1958, I, the Lieutenant-Governor as Deputy for the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation appoint the day and date mentioned hereunder to be observed as a Bank Holiday at the places respectively specified:

Bank Holiday

Friday, 12 October 1984 at Mooroopna in the Shire of Rodney.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this second day of October in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-four and in the thirty-third year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.

# Bank Holidays Act 1958 ALTERATION OF DAY APPOINTED AS A BANK HOLIDAY

### **PROCLAMATION**

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas pursuant to section 5 of the Bank Holidays Act 1958, Tuesday, 16 October 1984 has been proclaimed to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout the Shire of Karkarooc:

And whereas it is made to appear to the Governor in Council expedient that the said day should not be a bank holiday throughout the Shire of Karkarooc:

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, and in pursuance of the powers conferred by sections 5 and 7 of the Bank Holidays Act 1958, do by this my Proclamation—

- 1. declare that Tuesday, 16 October 1984, shall not be a bank holiday throughout the Shire of Karkarooc; and
- 2. appoint Tuesday, 23 October 1984 to be a bank holiday throughout the Shire of Karkarooc.
  - Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this eleventh day of October in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-four and in the thirty-third year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
