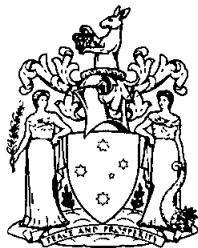

Workers Compensation (Amendment) Act 1984, No. 10100
DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the thirty-third year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second Queen of Australia, entitled the *Workers Compensation (Amendment) Act 1984, No. 10100* it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day or on the respective days to be fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations by the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.

Now therefore, I the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this proclamation fix Thursday, 11 October, 1984, as the day on which sections 4, 6, 7, 8, 10, 12, 13, 15 and 17 of the *Workers Compensation (Amendment) Act 1984, No. 10100* shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this eleventh day of October in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty-four and in the thirty-third year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
