\$50 000

The co-operation of the general public is sought with a view to establishing the identity of the person or persons responsible for the death of Bernard Joseph Williams, who was found deceased, from gunshot wounds, in Hobbs Road, Bullengarook on 3 March 1984.

A reward of fifty thousand dollars (\$50 000) will be paid, at the discretion of the Chief Commissioner of Police, by the Government of Victoria for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for this murder.

Any information, which will be treated as confidential, may be given at any time of the day or night to the Officer in Charge, Criminal Investigation Branch, Russell Street, Melbourne (Telephone No. 667 1911), or to the Officer in Charge of any Police Station.
