## CONSTITUTION ACT 1975

### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas it is provided by section 35 of the *Constitution Act 1975* that the Governor in Council may by Proclamation published in the *Government Gazette* divide any Electoral District of the Legislative Assembly into subdivisions, specify the names and boundaries of subdivisions and alter the name and boundaries of any subdivision and that the subdivisions and the names and boundaries thereof shall be such as are specified in any such Proclamation:

And whereas by a Proclamation made on the sixteenth day of October, 1984, and published in the *Government Gazette* of the sixteenth day of October, 1984, the Electoral Districts of Benalla and Rodney as published in the *Government Gazette* of the thirteenth day of April, 1984, were, among others, divided into subdivisions and the names and boundaries thereof were specified as set out in the Schedule to the said Proclamation:

And whereas it is desirable that the said Electoral Districts of Benalla and Rodney shall be divided into subdivisions in some respects differing from the subdivisions named and specified in the Proclamation published as aforesaid in the *Government Gazette* of the sixteenth day of October, 1984:

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation divide the Electoral Districts of Benalla and Rodney aforementioned into the subdivisions the names and boundaries of which are specified in connexion therewith in the Schedule hereto.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-ninth day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty-four and in the thirty-third year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.

Commencing on the Great Dividing Range at the south-eastern angle of the Parish of Koonika; thence northerly and westerly by the eastern and northern boundaries of that parish to the Dandongadale River; thence generally northerly by

that river to a point in line with the south-western boundary of allotment 24, Parish of Matong North; thence north-westerly by a line, the south-western boundary of allotment 24, a line, the south-western boundary of allotment 24A and a line to the Rose River; thence generally north-easterly by that river to the eastern boundary of the Parish of Winteriga; thence generally northerly by that boundary and the eastern boundary of the Parish of Bungamero to the southern boundary of the Parish of Whorouly; thence generally westerly and north-westerly by the southern and western boundaries of that parish to the southern boundary of the Parish of Oxley; thence generally westerly by that boundary and the southern boundary of the Parish of Laceby to the eastern boundary of the Parish of Glenrowan; thence generally southerly, westerly, and north-westerly by the eastern, southern and western boundaries of that parish to shore of Lake Mokoan; thence generally south-westerly and north-westerly by the southern and western shores of that lake to the Mokoan Outlet Channel; thence generally westerly by that channel to the Broken River; thence south-easterly by that river and southerly by the eastern boundaries of the Parishes of Goomalibee and Warrenbayne to the southern boundary of the Parish of Kelfeera; thence easterly by that boundary to the western boundary of the Parish of Rothesay; thence southerly and easterly by the western and southern boundaries of that parish to the Holland Creek; thence generally south-easterly by that creek to the northern boundary of the Parish of Dueran East; thence westerly by that boundary to the 40.23 metre road forming the eastern boundary of allotment 13C, section A; thence generally southerly and south-easterly by that road to a road forming the south-eastern boundary of allotment 9; thence north-easterly by that road to a road forming the north-eastern boundary of allotment 24B, section B; thence south-easterly by that road to a road forming the northern and eastern boundaries of allotment 25; thence easterly and southerly by that road to the south-western angle of allotment 8, section C; thence easterly by the southern boundary of that allotment and a line to the King River West Branch; thence south-easterly by a direct line to Mount Howitt on the Great Dividing Range; and thence generally north-easterly by that range to the point of commencement.

##### SUBDIVISION OF SEYMOUR

Commencing at Mount Howitt on the Great Dividing Range; thence north-westerly by a direct line to a point on the King River West Branch in line with the southern boundary of allotment 8, section C, Parish of Dueran East; thence westerly by a line and that boundary to the south-western angle of the said allotment; thence northerly and westerly by the road forming the eastern and northern boundaries of allotment 25, section B, and north-westerly by the road forming the north-eastern boundary of allotment 24B to the northern angle of the latter allotment; thence south-westerly by the road forming the south-eastern boundary of allotment 9, section A, to the road deviation through that allotment and allotment 10, section A; thence north-westerly and northerly

by that road to the north-eastern angle of allotment 13C, section A, at the northern boundary of the Parish of Dueran East; thence easterly by that boundary to the Holland Creek; thence north-westerly by that creek to the southern boundary of the Parish of Moorngag; thence westerly by that boundary to the eastern boundary of the Parish of Nillahcootie; thence southerly by the latter boundary to the Back Creek; thence north-westerly by that creek to the Broken River; thence southerly by that river to the Sandy Creek; thence south-westerly by that creek to its source; thence south-westerly and north-westerly by the Strathbogie Range to the eastern boundary of allotment 4, section C, parish of Too-rour; thence northerly by that boundary and the eastern boundary of allotment 5 and westerly by the northern boundary of the last mentioned allotment to the north-western angle thereof; thence northerly by the road forming the western boundary of the Parish of Too-rour to the southern angle of allotment 9, section D, parish of Lima; thence north-westerly by the road forming the north-eastern boundaries of the Parishes of Strathbogie and Marraweeny to the northern angle of allotment 5, section A, in the last named parish, and further north-westerly by a road to the eastern angle of allotment 163, Parish of Balmattum; thence south-westerly by a road to the southern angle of that allotment; thence north-westerly by a road to the northern angle of allotment 96C; thence south-westerly by a road to the eastern angle of allotment 96B; thence north-westerly by a road to the road forming the south-eastern boundary of the Parish of Moglonemby, and north-easterly by that road to the southern angle of allotment 44 in the said parish; thence northerly by a road to the Murchison-Violet Town Road; thence westerly by that road to the road forming the western boundary of allotment 74, Parish of Molka; thence southerly by that road to the road forming the northern boundary of allotment 81C; thence westerly by that road to the road forming the western boundary of allotment 43A, Parish of Dargalong; thence southerly by that road to the road forming the northern boundary of allotment 25B; thence westerly by that road and a line in continuation to the Goulburn River; thence generally westerly and southerly by that river to the road forming the south-western boundary of allotment 1240A, Parish of Noorilim; thence north-westerly by that road to the northern boundary of that parish; thence south-westerly and westerly by that boundary and generally westerly by the northern boundaries of the Parishes of Bailieston and Wirrate and southerly by the western boundary of the last named parish to the southern boundary of the County of Rodney; thence generally south-westerly by that boundary to the eastern boundary of the Parish of Costerfield; thence generally south-easterly by that boundary to Splitters Creek; thence generally south-easterly by that creek, and generally easterly by Wappentake Creek to Major Creek; thence generally southerly by that creek to the northern boundary of the Parish of Warrowitue; thence generally easterly by that boundary and the northern boundary of the Parish of Puckapunyal and generally southerly by the eastern boundary of the last named parish to the south-western angle of allotment 5A, section C, Parish of Northwood; thence southerly by a line to the northern boundary of allotment 4; thence easterly by the northern boundary of that allotment, the northern boundary of allotment 4B and the northern boundary of allotment 4 again, and southerly by the eastern boundaries of allotments 4 and 4A to the south-eastern angle of allotment 4A; thence westerly by the southern boundary of that allotment and north-westerly by the south-western boundary of allotment 12B, section A, Parish of Puckapunyal to a point in line with the north-western boundary of allotment 12A; thence south-westerly by a line and the north-western boundary of allotment 12A to the northern boundary of the Shire of

Pyalong; thence easterly by that boundary and southerly by the eastern boundary of that shire to the south-eastern angle of allotment 23; thence westerly by the southern boundary of that allotment to the north-western angle of allotment 24; thence southerly by the western boundary of that allotment to the road forming the southern boundary of the said allotment; thence easterly by that road to the road forming the western boundary of allotment 27A; thence southerly by that road and easterly by the road forming the southern boundary of that allotment to the eastern boundary of the Shire of Pyalong; thence generally southerly by that boundary to the northern boundary of the Shire of Broadford; thence easterly by that shire boundary to Dabyminga Creek; thence generally south-easterly by that creek to a point in line with the northern boundary of allotment 13, section D, parish of Kerrisdale; thence easterly by a line, the northern boundary of allotment 13, a line and the southern boundary of allotment 10 and northerly by the eastern boundary of the last mentioned allotment to the southern boundary of allotment 10C; thence easterly by that boundary and northerly and westerly by the eastern and northern boundaries of that allotment to the northern boundary of the Parish of Kerrisdale; thence northerly and generally easterly and south-easterly by that parish boundary to the western boundary of the Parish of Windham; thence generally northerly by that boundary to the Goulburn Valley Highway; thence generally south-easterly by that highway to the King Parrot Creek; thence generally south-westerly and south-easterly by that creek to a point in line with the road forming the northern boundary of allotment 113A, Parish of Windham; thence easterly by a line, the road forming the northern boundary of allotment 113A, a line, and generally easterly by the road forming the northern boundary of allotment 113B, and northerly by the road forming the eastern boundary of allotment 112A to the road forming the northern boundary of allotment 112C; thence easterly and generally south-easterly by that road to the northern boundary of allotment 256, Parish of Yea; thence easterly by that boundary and southerly by the eastern boundary of that allotment to the southern boundary of allotment 255; thence easterly by that boundary to the road forming the south-western boundary of allotment 196; thence south-easterly by that road to the Whittlesea-Yea Road; thence generally easterly by that road to the road forming the eastern boundary of allotment 212E; thence generally south-easterly by that road to Ti Tree Creek; thence generally by that creek and northerly by the Yea River to the Murrindindi River; thence generally south-easterly by that river to a point in line with the northern boundary of allotment 5B, Parish of Murrindindi; thence easterly by a line, the northern boundaries of allotments 5B and 5A, a line, the northern boundary of allotment 5 and the northern boundary of allotment 37, section A, and southerly by the eastern boundary of the last mentioned allotment to the road forming the northern boundary of allotment 41; thence north-easterly by that road to the south-western angle of allotment 40; thence easterly by the southern boundary of that allotment, the southern boundary of allotment 40A and a line in continuation to the summit of the range forming the watershed between the Acheron River and the Murrindindi River; thence generally southerly by that watershed to the southern boundary of the Parish of Glendale; thence easterly by that boundary and southerly by the Acheron River to the southern boundary of the Parish of Taggerty; thence north-easterly, south-easterly and easterly by the southern boundary of the Parish of Taggerty to the south-eastern angle of allotment 26; thence south-easterly by a direct line to Mount Arnold on the Great Dividing Range; and thence generally south-easterly, easterly and north-easterly by that range to the point of commencement.

## SUBDIVISION OF VIOLET TOWN

Commencing at the south-west corner of the Parish of Tamleugh, thence easterly by the southern boundary of that parish to the north-eastern angle of allotment 4, Parish of Moglonemby; thence southerly by a road and south-westerly by the road forming the south-eastern boundary of the parish to the western angle of allotment 66, Parish of Balmattum; thence south-easterly by a road to the eastern angle of allotment 96B; thence north-easterly, south-easterly and north-easterly by a road to the most eastern angle of allotment 163; thence south-easterly by a road to the northern angle of allotment 5, section A, Parish of Marraweeny, and further south-easterly by the road forming the north-eastern boundary of that parish to the eastern angle of allotment 20; thence south-easterly and southerly by the roads forming the north-eastern and eastern boundaries of the Parish of Strathbogie to the northern boundary of allotment 5, section C, Parish of Too-rour; thence easterly by that boundary and southerly by the eastern boundaries of the said allotment and allotment 4 to the south-eastern angle of that allotment; thence south-easterly and north-easterly by the Strathbogie Range to the source of the Sandy Creek; thence north-easterly by that creek to the Broken River; thence northerly by that river to Back Creek; thence south-easterly by that creek to the eastern boundary of the Parish of Nillahcootie; thence northerly by that boundary to the southern boundary of the Parish of Moorgag; thence easterly by that boundary to the Holland Creek; thence generally north-westerly by that creek to the southern boundary of the Parish of Rothesay; thence westerly and northerly by the southern and western boundaries of that parish to the southern boundary of the Parish of Kelfeera; thence westerly by the southern boundary of that parish to the Benalla-Warrenbayne Road; thence northerly by that road and the eastern boundaries of the parishes of Warrenbayne and Goomalibee to the Broken River; thence generally westerly by that river to a point in line with the road forming the eastern boundary of allotment 17, Parish of Caniambo; thence southerly by a line, that road and Keallys Road to Bells Road; thence westerly by that road to Thorns Road; thence southerly by that road to Cemetery Road; thence westerly by that road to the western boundary of the Parish of Caniambo; and thence southerly by that boundary and the western boundary of the Parish of Tamleugh to the point of commencement.

Commencing on the Goulburn River at a point in line with the road forming the eastern boundary of allotment 41, Parish of Coomboona; thence southerly by a line and that road, Ross Road and Minchins Road to the northern boundary of allotment 53, Parish of Moorooopna; thence westerly by that boundary to Starritts Road; thence southerly by that road to Lilford Road; thence westerly by that road to Mulcahy Road; thence southerly by that road to Fenaughty-Leene Road; thence westerly by that road to Ryan-Donaldsons Road; thence southerly by that road to the Tatura-Byrneside-Kyabram Road; thence westerly by that road to the eastern boundary of the Parish of Girgarre East; thence southerly by the eastern boundaries of that parish and the Parish of Waranga to the Waranga Reservoir; thence south-easterly and south-westerly by the bank of that reservoir to the eastern boundary of the Parish of Waranga; thence southerly by the eastern boundaries of that parish and the Parish of Whroo to the southern boundary of the last named parish; thence westerly by that boundary and southerly by the eastern boundaries of the Parishes of Gobarup and Cherrington to the southern boundary of the County of

Rodney; thence generally south-westerly by that county boundary to a point in line with the southern boundary of allotment 16, Parish of Redcastle; thence westerly by a line to the south-eastern angle of allotment 16; thence northerly by a road to Connallys Lane; thence westerly by that lane to the Redcastle Creek; thence northerly by the Redcastle Creek to its junction with the Cornella Creek; thence westerly by the Cornella Creek to Eickert's Lane; thence generally westerly by that lane to the Heathcote-Rochester Road; thence south-westerly by that road to Hagans Road; thence westerly by that road and the Axedale-Crosbie Road to the road forming the western boundary of allotment 24, section C, Parish of Crosbie; thence northerly by that road to the northern boundary of the parish; thence westerly by that boundary and the southern boundary of the Parish of Muskerry to the Campaspe River; thence generally north-easterly by that river to the northern boundary of the Parish of Nolan; thence westerly by that boundary to the north-western angle of allotment 1, section 1; thence northerly by a road to the Bendigo Creek; thence generally north-westerly by that creek and the Piccaninny Creek to the southern boundary of the Shire of Rochester; thence generally westerly and northerly by the southern and western boundaries of that shire to the western boundary of Kow Swamp; thence generally northerly by that boundary to Box Creek; thence generally north-westerly by that creek and Pyramid Creek to a point in line with the road forming the eastern boundary of allotment 1A, section C, Parish of Macorna; thence northerly by a line and that road to the Kerang-Leitchville Road; thence westerly by that road to Semples Road; thence northerly by that road to Olives Road; thence westerly by that road to Meads Road; thence northerly by that road to the northern boundary of the Parish of Macorna; thence easterly by that boundary to Coopers Road; thence northerly by that road and a line to Barr Creek; thence north-westerly by that creek to a point in line with the eastern boundary of allotment 50C, Parish of Gannawarra; thence northerly by a line, the eastern boundary of allotment 50C, Wests Road and La Times Road to the north-eastern angle of allotment 71; thence easterly by a road to the Cohuna-Koondrook Road; thence south-easterly by that road to Orrs Road; thence northerly by that road and a line to the Gunbower Creek; thence generally south-easterly by that creek to a point thereon in line with the southern boundary of allotment 1, section A, Parish of Cohuna; thence easterly by a direct line to the northern boundary of the State; thence generally south-easterly by that State Boundary to the Goulburn River; and thence generally south-easterly by that river to the point of commencement.

PROCLAMATION

Whereas it is provided by section 27 of the *Constitution Act 1975* that the Governor in Council may by Proclamation published in the *Government Gazette* divide any Electoral Province of the Legislative Council into subdivisions, specify the names and boundaries of subdivisions and alter the name and boundaries of any subdivision provided that each subdivision of an Electoral Province shall correspond with a subdivision of an Electoral District and that the subdivisions and the names and boundaries thereof shall be such as are specified in any such Proclamation:

And whereas by a Proclamation made on the twenty-fourth day of December, 1975, and published in the *Government Gazette* of the nineteenth day of January, 1976, the Electoral Province of North Eastern as declared by Proclamation of the twenty-ninth day of July, 1975, was, among other Electoral Provinces, divided into subdivisions and the names and boundaries of such subdivisions thereof were specified as set out in the Schedule to such first-mentioned Proclamation:

And whereas there have been changes in the subdivisions of various Electoral Districts and it is consequently expedient that the said Electoral Province of North Eastern shall be divided into subdivisions in some respects differing from the subdivisions named and specified in the Proclamation aforementioned published in the *Government Gazette* of the nineteenth day of January, 1976:

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation divide the said Electoral Province of North Eastern into the subdivisions the names and boundaries of which are specified in connection therewith in the Schedule hereto.

Commencing at a point on the State Boundary where the eastern boundary of the Parish of Gooramadda abuts thereon; thence generally easterly and southerly by the State Boundary to a point thereon in a direct line from Mount Gibbo to Forest Hill; thence north-westerly by a direct line to Mount Gibbo; thence south-westerly by a direct line to Mount Cooper; thence south-westerly by the watershed of the Snowy Creek to Mount Wills; thence north-westerly by the said watershed to Mount Bogong; thence generally south-westerly by the watershed of the Kiewa River to Mount Hotham; thence south-westerly by the Great Dividing Range to the south-eastern angle of the Parish of Koonika; thence northerly and westerly by the eastern and northern boundaries of that parish to the Dandongadale River; thence generally northerly by that river to a point in line with the south-western boundary of allotment 24, Parish of Matong North; thence north-westerly by a line, the south-western boundary of allotment 24, a line, the south-western boundary of allotment 24A and a line to the Rose River; thence generally north-easterly by that river to the eastern boundary of the Parish of Winteriga; thence generally northerly by that boundary and the eastern boundary of the Parish of Bungamero to the southern boundary of the Parish of Whorouly; thence generally north-easterly by the eastern boundary of that parish to a point 211 metres, more or less, west of the Merriang South Road; thence northerly by a line to a point on the southern boundary of allotment 165, 310 metres, more or less, west of the Merriang South Road; thence westerly by the southern boundary of allotment 165 to the western boundary of that allotment; thence northerly by the western boundaries of allotments 165, 165D, 166A, 166, 167 and 168 to the southern boundary

of allotment 169; thence generally westerly and northerly by the southern and western boundaries of that allotment to the southern boundary of allotment 111; thence westerly and northerly by the southern and western boundaries of that allotment to the southern boundary of allotment 110; thence generally north-westerly and northerly by the southern and western boundaries of that allotment and a line to the south-western angle of allotment 109; thence generally north-easterly by the western and northern boundaries of that allotment to the north-western angle of allotment 109D; thence southerly and easterly by the western and southern boundaries of that allotment and further easterly by a line to the Ovens River; thence generally south-easterly by that river to the western boundary of the Parish of Myrtleford; thence generally northerly by the western boundaries of the Parishes of Myrtleford, Mudgegonga and Stanley to the south-eastern angle of the Parish of Beechworth; thence generally westerly, northerly and easterly by the southern, western and northern boundaries of the Parish of Beechworth to the western boundary of the Parish of Wooragee; thence northerly by that boundary to the southern boundary of the Shire of Chiltern; thence easterly by that shire boundary to the western boundary of the Barnawartha Riding of that shire; thence generally northerly by that riding boundary to the Chiltern-Yackandandah Road; thence westerly by that road to the Fryingpan Creek; and thence generally northerly by that creek, Indigo Creek and the eastern boundary of the Parish of Gooramadda to the point of commencement.

#### SUBDIVISION OF MURRAY VALLEY

Whereas pursuant to the *Electoral Commission Act 1982* the State of Victoria has been divided into twenty-two new electoral provinces for the Legislative Council and into eighty-eight new electoral districts for the Legislative Assembly and the names and boundaries of such new electoral provinces and new electoral districts have been duly published in the *Government Gazette* of 13 April 1984:
