Fisheries (Abalone Licences) Act 1984 DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the thirty-third year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia, entitled the Fisheries (Abalone Licences) Act 1984, No. 10035, it is amongst other things enacted that the Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette.

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Tuesday, 10 April 1984, as the day upon which the said Fisheries (Abalone Licences) Act 1984, No. 10035, shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this tenth day of April, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty-four and in the thirty-third year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
