Notice is hereby given that an application has been lodged by the Secretary of the Federated Ironworkers Association of Australia (Victorian Branch) for:

1. Abolition of the—
Engineers and Brassworkers (Unskilled);
Filemakers;
Industrial Gases;
Iron and Steel Rolling;
Nailmakers;
Wire Fence and Tubular Gate; and
Wireworkers Conciliation and Arbitration Boards.
2. Appointment of a Conciliation and Arbitration Board to replace the abolished Boards.
3. Variation to the jurisdiction of the Boilermakers Conciliation and Arbitration Board and the Ironmoulders Conciliation and Arbitration Board by depriving those Boards of their jurisdiction in respect of non-tradespersons and conferring that jurisdiction on the new Conciliation and Arbitration Board sought to be appointed.
