GRAIN HANDLING IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITIES (ABOLITION) ACT 1984

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the thirty-third year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth II, Queen of Australia, entitled the *Grain Handling Improvement Authorities (Abolition) Act 1984* No. 10049 it is amongst other things enacted that the Geelong Grain Handling Improvement Authority, the Portland Grain Handling Improvement Authority and the Country Grain Handling Improvement Authority shall be abolished and all rights, properties duties and obligations of these Authorities shall be transferred to the Grain Elevators Board upon "the appointed day" to be fixed by proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*:

Now, therefore, I the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix this third day of July, One thousand nine hundred and eighty-four as "the appointed day" for the purpose of Sections four and six of the said *Grain Handling Improvement Authorities (Abolition) Act 1984*.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this third day of July in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty-four and in the thirty-third year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
