I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do hereby declare that I have this day assented, in Her Majesty's name, to the Bill passed by the Parliament of the said State, the title whereof is hereunder set forth, together with the short title, that is to say:

No. 10193. "An Act to amend the *Racing Act 1958* with respect to the distribution of the residue of commission by the Totalizator Agency Board, to repeal section 16 of the *Racing (Amendment) Act 1983* and the *Racing (Amendment) Act 1984* and for other purposes. *Racing (Fixed Percentage Distribution) Act 1985*.

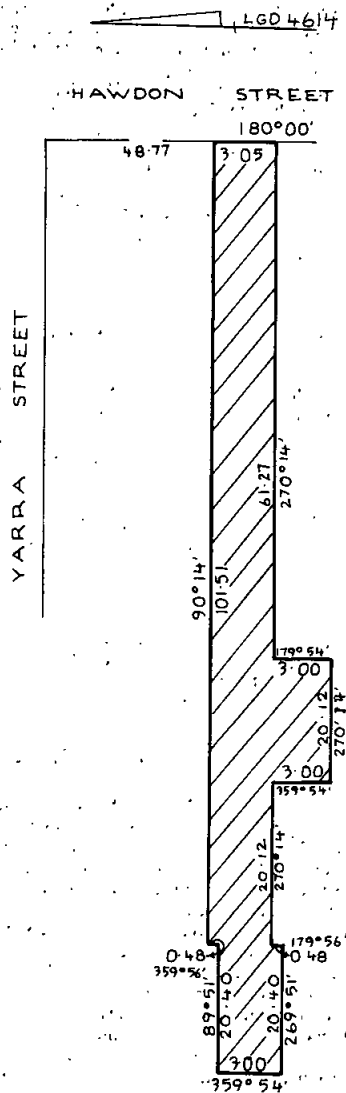
PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by the *Local Government Act 1958*, section 519 it is amongst other things enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council at any time and from time to time upon the request of the council of any municipality by notice in the *Government Gazette* to proclaim any land reserved used or by purchase or exchange acquired for a street road highway thoroughfare bridge square court alley or right-of-way or any street road lane or passage made or laid out or proposed to be made or laid out on any land of which a plan of subdivision delineating that street road lane or passage has been sealed with the seal of the municipality under subdivision (3) of Division 9 of Part XIX of the *Local Government Act 1958* or a corresponding previous enactment to be a public highway and that such land shall thereupon and thenceforth from the date of such proclamation become and be absolutely dedicated to the public as a public highway within the meaning of any law then or thereafter in force.

And whereas the Council of the City of Heidelberg has requested that the land hereinafter mentioned, being a street road lane or passage made or laid out or proposed to be made or laid out on land of which a plan of subdivision delineating such street road lane or passage has been sealed with the seal of the municipality under subdivision (3) of Division 9 of Part XIX of the *Local Government Act 1958*, or a corresponding previous enactment be so declared to be a public highway.

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this proclamation declare that a road off Hawdon Street, Heidelberg as shown by hatching on the plan hereunder shall be a public highway within the meaning of the said Act.

ALTERATION OF A DAY ON WHICH CERTAIN SHOPS ARE REQUIRED TO BE CLOSED AND KEPT CLOSED IN THE GEELONG URBAN AREA

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by section 80 (2E) of the *Labour and Industry Act 1958*, all shops in the Geelong Urban Area (except petrol shops, shops for the sale of motor cars and shops to which, by reason of sub-section (2F) or (2I) this sub-section does not apply) shall in each year be closed and kept closed on the third Wednesday in October for the whole of the day.

And whereas it is made to appear to the Governor in Council that in this year it is expedient that another day should be substituted as a day on which those shops in the Geelong Urban Area shall be closed and kept closed in accordance with the provisions of the said sub-section (2E).

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the powers conferred by section 80 (2D) of the said Act, do by this my Proclamation—

1. declare that the shops subject to the provisions of section 80 (2E) shall not be required to be closed and kept closed on Wednesday, 16 October 1985 for the whole of the day; and
2. appoint Wednesday, 23 October 1985 as the substituted day on which those shops, subject to the provisions of section 80 (2E) shall be closed and kept closed for the whole of the day.
