## FIXING THE TIME FOR HOLDING THE FIRST SESSION OF THE FIFTIETH PARLIAMENT OF VICTORIA

### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria  
and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of  
Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the  
Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my  
Proclamation fix Wednesday, 3 April 1985, as the time  
for the commencement and holding of the First Session  
of the Fiftieth Parliament of Victoria, for the despatch  
of business, at the hour of Eleven forty-five o'clock in  
the forenoon, in the Parliament House, situated in  
Spring Street in the City of Melbourne: And the  
Honourable the Members of the Legislative Council  
and the Members of the Legislative Assembly are hereby  
required to give their attendance at the said time and  
place accordingly.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of  
Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this  
nineteenth day of March in the year of our  
Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty-  
five and in the thirty-fourth year of the reign  
of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second,  
Queen of Australia.
