Weights and Measures Act 1958
ALTERATION OF CONSTITUTION OF THE
CENTRAL HIGHLANDS WEIGHTS AND
MEASURES UNION

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c.

Whereas by section 44 of the Weights and Measures Act 1958, it is amongst other things enacted that the Governor in Council may at the request of the councils of all the municipalities constituting a Union by proclamation alter or revoke any proclamation declaring such municipalities to be a Union for the purposes of the said Act.

And whereas the Cities of Castlemaine and Maryborough and the Shires of Avoca, Broadford, Kilmore, Kyneton, Lexton, Maldon, Metcalfe, McIvor, Newham and Woodend, Newstead, Pyalong, Romsey, Talbot and Clunes, and Tullaroop do constitute a Union for the purposes of the Weights and Measures Act 1958, under the name of "Central Highlands Weights and Measures Union".

And whereas the Councils of each of the said municipalities and the Council of the Shire of Daylesford and Glenlyon have requested that the Shire of Daylesford and Glenlyon be added to and form part of the said Union.

Now therefore, I, the Lieutenant-Governor as Deputy for the Governor of the State of Victoria by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State and in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Weights and Measures Act 1958, do by this proclamation alter the proclamation under which the Central Highlands Weights and Measures Union is constituted on and from 1 April 1985, and declare that on and from such date:

(a) the Cities of Castlemaine and Maryborough and the Shires of Avoca, Broadford, Daylesford and Glenlyon, Kilmore, Kyneton, Lexton, Maldon, Metcalfe, McIvor, Newham and Woodend, Newstead, Pyalong, Romsey, Talbot and Clunes, and Tullaroop shall constitute a Union under the name "Central Highlands Weights and Measures Union"; and (b) the apportionment of expenses devolving on the municipalities in the said Union shall be fixed as follows:

 - (c) offer any article of food or drink or any other commodity whatsoever for sale in the Reserve or bring intoxicating liquor thereon without the written consent of the Committee first obtained;
 - (d) remove or displace or damage in any way whatsoever the whole or any part of any notice, sign board, tablet, plate or any support or fastening or fitting used or constructed or adapted to be used for the exhibition of any notice sign or Regulations in the Reserve and fixed or set up by the Committee;
 - (e) obstruct, hinder or interfere with any person employed on the Reserve;
- (f) climb, jump on or get over any of the trees, gates, barriers, railings, fences or other structures in or around the Reserve, or lie on any seat or other structure in an objectionable manner, or write or cut names, letters or marks on any seat, roof, gate, post, fence or other structure in the Reserve;
- (g) post, stick, paint or otherwise affix or mark any advertisement, bill, placard or other notice on any structure, erection, rock, tree or anything else in or around the Reserve, or give out or distribute any handbill, placard, notice, advertisement book pamphlet or paper therein;
- (h) interfere with, break or damage in any way any
 of the trees, shrubs or plants in the Reserve or
 pluck flowers or destroy or cut grasses therein;

- (i) leave or deposit any bottle, broken glass, paper, orange peel, banana skin, refuse or rubbish whatsoever in the Reserve except in the receptacles provided by the Committee for such purpose, nor roll or throw stones or missiles of any kind therein, or leave anything that might injure a person;
- (j) light a fire in the Reserve except at such places as are set apart for the purpose by the Committee;
- (k) carry, use, or discharge any firework, firearm, air gun or other lethal weapon in the Reserve;
- (I) carry any poison, trap or snare in the Reserve, or shoot, snare or destroy any animal or bird thereon;
- (m) gamble or bet publicly in the Reserve;
- (n) erect any building, tent or other structure on any portion of the Reserve without permission, in writing, of the Committee first obtained, and then only under such conditions as may be determined by the said Committee;
- (o) bring into the Reserve any dog unless controlled by a chain or cord without the permission, in writing, of the Committee first obtained:
- (p) do anything whatsoever in the Reserve for the purpose of making money without the consent, in writing, of the Committee first obtained;
- (q) take part in any public meeting or assembly for public worship, or preach, declaim, harangue or deliver any address or public speech of any kind without the permission in writing of the Committee first obtained:
- (r) interfere with or interrupt any game, sport, competition, fete, entertainment, amusement or musical performance in the Reserve;
- (s) on any portion of the Reserve cause or permit any outcry, sound or noise to be emitted from any amplifier, loud speaker, public address system or like instrument without first obtaining the written permission of the Committee, and such permission may be granted subject to such terms, conditions and restrictions as may be imposed by the Committee;

Every person infringing this Regulation in any respect shall be liable to expulsion from the Reserve in addition to any other penalty to which such person may be liable.

- 3. For the purpose of good order, any person authorized by the Committee may refuse admission to any person to the Reserve.
- 4. (a) The Committee may, by clear notices or signs established in such prominent position or positions as the case requires, prohibit or regulate any act, matter or thing within the Reserve or any part thereof;
- (b) No person shall erect or remove any such notice or sign except with the authority of the Committee;
- (c) No person shall disobey the directions indicated in any such notice or sign.

- 5. If in the opinion of an authorized officer, any person has contravened or failed to comply with any provision of these Regulations then such officer may demand and receive the name and address of such person and any person who refuses when asked by such officer to furnish his name and address shall be deemed to have committed an offence against these Regulations.
- No person shall obstruct, hinder or interfere with any authorized officer or any employee of the Committee in the execution of his duty in the Reserve.
- 7. Every person infringing any of these Regulations may be removed from the Reserve or from any property therein, or directed to forthwith leave the Reserve or such property therein by any officer or employee of the Committee or by any Bailiff of Crown Lands or by any member of the Police Force.
- 8. The Committee may set apart any portion or portions or all of the Reserve for the purpose of any lawful game or sport, picnic or other recreational activity and from time to time grant to any person, club, association or organization upon such terms and conditions as the Committee may deem to be consistent with these Regulations, the use of the ground or grounds so set apart.
- 9. No club, association or person shall hold or take any part in any game of any description, entertainment, performance, show or ceremony in any part of the Reserve without the written authority of the Committee first obtained and then only subject to the payment of such fees and such terms and conditions as the Committee deems to be reasonable and consistent with these Regulations.
- 10. No person, except the Committee or its officers and employees on duty, shall enter any part of the Reserve when a charge for admission is made without first paying the fees chargeable for admission.
- 11. No person shall park a motor car, caravan, motorcycle or other vehicle within the reserve except at such places, if any, as are set apart for the purpose.
- 12. No person shall take, ride, drive, put, allow to be taken or put in the Reserve any horse, cattle, sheep, goat, pig or other animal, except as hereinbefore provided, without the written consent of the Committee.
- 13. The owner of any horse, sheep, cattle, goat, pig or other animal found wandering upon any part of the Reserve without the written authority of the Committee shall be guilty of an offence against these Regulations.
- 14. The driver of a motor car entering the Reserve shall proceed at a speed not exceeding five (5) kilometres per hour in a direction indicated by persons appointed by the Committee to control vehicular traffic therein.
- 15. The use of mini-bikes, trail bikes and similar recreational vehicles shall not be permitted on the Reserve without the written authority of the Committee and then only under such conditions as may be determined by the said Committee.





By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

And whereas by proclamation dated 27 May 1969, and published in the Government Gazette dated 4 June 1969, and 8 December 1970, and published in the Government Gazette dated 9 December 1970, the Governor in Council did revoke the proclamation constituting the Mental Hospital Warrnambool so far as they related to the buildings known as Ward M3, Ward M4 and Ward M5 and did proclaim such buildings to be a training centre known as the Training Centre Warrnambool.
