### Films (Classification) Act 1984 EXEMPTION PURSUANT TO S.4(3)

Pursuant to the powers conferred by s.4(3) of the Films (Classification) Act 1984, I, James Harley Kennan, Her Majesty's Attorney-General for the State of Victoria, hereby exempt a film included in the classes of film set out in the Schedule below from the provisions of section 20 of the Act subject to the condition that the film would, if classified, be classified as a "G" film. SCHEDULE

- 1. Video films of an educational or instructional nature.
- 2. Video films portraying solely pictures of sporting or cultural events.

#### Films (Classification) Act 1984 EXEMPTION PURSUANT TO S.4(1)

Pursuant to the powers conferred by s.4(1) of the Films (Classification) Act 1984, I, James Harley Kennan, Her Majesty's Attorney-General for the State of Victoria, hereby exempt from the provisions of section 20 of the Act—

- (a) The State Film Centre of Victoria Council; and
- (b) Persons who sell or deliver video films to the State Film Centre of Victoria Council, this exemption applying only for the purposes of such sale or delivery.
