ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION ACT 1970
(No. 8056)

PRESENT:

His Excellency the Governor of Victoria

Whereas by paragraph (b) of sub-section (3) of section 42A of the *Environment Protection Act 1970* it is an offence on or after 1 January 1983 for any person to sell or offer to sell any petrol which would, if tested at a temperature of 15° Celsius, contain lead in excess of 0.30 grams per litre.

And whereas by sub-section (13) of the said section the Governor in Council may in case of emergency (of which the Governor in Council shall be the sole judge) by Order publish in the *Government Gazette* exempt any person from compliance with the provisions of the said sub-section (3).

And whereas the Governor in Council is satisfied that an emergency exists.

Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof doth hereby exempt Mobil Oil Australia Ltd., from compliance with the provisions of the said sub-section (3) in connection with the sale or offering for sale by it or on its behalf thirty two point five million litres of petrol in Victoria during the period 9 December 1986 to 8 January 1987, provided that such petrol would, if tested at a temperature of 15° Celsius, contain lead not exceeding 0.39 grams per litre.

And the Honourable James Harley Kennan, Her Majesty's Minister for Planning and Environment for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
