Pursuant to section 107 of the Magistrates (Summary Proceedings) Act 1975, I, the Governor of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of Victoria, do by this Proclamation declare:

- 1. The State of South Australia being a State or Territory having laws providing for enforcement in that State or Territory of a fine payable under a conviction or order of a Magistrates' Court or other Court having a summary jurisdiction in Victoria against a body corporate in that State or Territory, to be a reciprocating State or Territory for the purpose of the enforcement in Victoria of a fine payable under a conviction or order of a Court having summary jurisdiction in the other State or Territory against a body corporate in Victoria; and
