And whereas the Council of the Shire of Cranbourne has requested that the land hereinafter mentioned, being a street road lane or passage made or laid out or proposed to be made or laid out on land of which a plan of subdivision delineating such street road lane or passage has been sealed with the seal of the municipality under subdivision (3) of Division 9 of Part XIX of the Local Government Act 1958, or a corresponding previous enactment be so declared to be a public highway;

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this proclamation declare that Elizabeth Street, Cranbourne coloured brown on Plan of Subdivision No. 43292, shall be a public highway within the meaning of the said Act.





The attendant and blasting vessels may also display any of the following signals by Internal Code flags:

Signal Meaning

"A" I have a diver down. Keep well clear at slow speed.

"B" I am carrying dangerous goods.

"U" You are running into danger.

"IR" I am engaged in submarine survey work (underwater operations). Keep clear of me and go slow.

"OW" Underwater mining operations are in progress. You should stop your vessel and wait for instructions.
