BLF (De-recognition) Act 1985, No. 10188 DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Deputy Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the thirty-fourth year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia, entitled the BLF (De-recognition) Act 1985, No. 10188 it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day or the respective days to be fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations of the Government Gazette:

Now therefore I the Deputy Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my proclamation fix Monday, 14 April 1986 as the day on which the said *BLF* (De-recognition) Act 1985, No. 10188 other than Sections 4, 5 and 7, shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this fourteenth day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty-six and in the thirty-fifth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
