Whereas by the *Local Government Act 1958*, section 519 it is amongst other things enacted that

it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council at any time and from time to time upon the request of the council of any municipality by notice in the *Government Gazette* to proclaim any land reserved used or by purchase or exchange acquired for a street road highway thoroughfare bridge square court alley or right-of-way or any street road lane or passage made or laid out or proposed to be made or laid out on any land of which a plan of subdivision delineating that street road lane or passage has been sealed with the seal of the municipality under subdivision (3) of Division 9 of Part XIX of the *Local Government Act 1958* or a corresponding previous enactment to be a public highway and that such land shall thereupon and thenceforth from the date of such proclamation become and be absolutely dedicated to the public as a public highway within the meaning of any law then or thereafter in force.

And whereas the Council of the City of South Barwon has requested that the land hereinafter mentioned, being a street road lane or passage made or laid out or proposed to be made or laid out on land of which a plan of subdivision delineating such street road lane or passage has been sealed with the seal of the municipality under subdivision (3) of Division 9 of Part XIX of the *Local Government Act 1958*, or a corresponding previous enactment be so declared to be a public highway.

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this proclamation declare that Clifford Parade, Barwon Heads as shown by hatching on the plan hereunder shall be a public highway within the meaning of the said Act.
