BLF (De-recognition) Act 1985, No. 10188 DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the thirty-fourth year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia, entitled the BLF (De-recognition) Act 1985, No. 10188 it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day or the respective days to be fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette.

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my proclamation fix—

- (a) Friday, I August 1986 as the day on which section 7 of the said BLF (De-recognition) Act 1985 shall come into operation.
- (b) Saturday, 1 January 2000 as the day on which sections 4 and 5 of the said BLF (Derecognition) Act 1985 shall come into operation.

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this proclamation declare that the road coloured brown on Plan of Subdivision No. 142594, shall be a public highway within the meaning of the said Act.


