Subordinate Legislation Act 1962

PROPOSED HEALTH (RADIATION SAFETY) (COMPUTER TOMOGRAPHY SCANNERS) REGULATIONS 1986

I, David Ronald White, Minister for Health, hereby give notice pursuant to the Subordinate Legislation Act 1986 as follows:

The proposed Health (Radiation Safety) (Computer Tomography Scanners) Regulations 1986 have been the subject of a regulatory impact statement:

Public comments and submissions have been invited and received and have been duly considered pursuant to section 12 of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1962;

After considering the comments and submissions received, the following amendments have been made to the proposed Regulations:

- (i) provision for private ownership or operation (under contract) of a CT scanner in a public hospital;
- (ii) provision for a previously registered scanner to be registered by a person who had already obtained approval for registration of a scanner;
- (iii) provision of a CT scanner in a public or private hospital to be relocated to a place other than in or adjacent to the hospital where it was previously registered; and
- (iv) some modification or clarification of the wording without any change to the meaning of the Regulations.

I have decided that the proposed Health (Radiation Safety) (Computer Tomography Scanners) Regulations 1986 as amended should be made.
