Subordinate Legislation Act 1962

PROPOSED HEALTH (RADIATION SAFETY)
(COMPUTER TOMOGRAPHY SCANNERS)
REGULATIONS 1986

I, David Ronald White, Minister for Health,
hereby give notice pursuant to the *Subordinate
Legislation Act 1986* as follows:

The proposed Health (Radiation Safety)
(Computer Tomography Scanners) Regulations
1986 have been the subject of a regulatory
impact statement:

Public comments and submissions have been
invited and received and have been duly
considered pursuant to section 12 of the
Subordinate Legislation Act 1962:

After considering the comments and
submissions received, the following
amendments have been made to the proposed
Regulations:

- (i) provision for private ownership or
operation (under contract) of a CT
scanner in a public hospital;
- (ii) provision for a previously registered
scanner to be registered by a person who
had already obtained approval for
registration of a scanner;
- (iii) provision of a CT scanner in a public or
private hospital to be relocated to a place
other than in or adjacent to the hospital
where it was previously registered; and
- (iv) some modification or clarification of the
wording without any change to the
meaning of the Regulations.

I have decided that the proposed Health
(Radiation Safety) (Computer Tomography
Scanners) Regulations 1986 as amended should
be made.
