

Amendment No. 140

Notice is hereby given that the Geelong Regional Commission in pursuance of its powers under the Town and Country Planning Act 1961, has prepared an Amending Scheme for the Geelong Regional Planning Scheme Ordinance.

The Amendment proposes to include various Buildings, Works, Objects and Sites of Architectural, Historic or Scientific Interest or of Natural Beauty into a Schedule to the Scheme in order to provide for their preservation, maintenance and enhancement.

The Amendment also proposes several changes to the form of controls in the Scheme:

It provides statutory protection for the 453 Buildings in that a permit is required for the demolition or alteration of such buildings.

It places responsibility for determining applications for development at the appropriate level

It specifies whether the reasons for inclusion are architectural, historical or scientific.

It introduces Urban Conservation Precinct controls in the Borough of Queenscliffe.

It introduces controls to encourage the protection of significant trees in Queenscliff.

It modifies the provisions for adaptive use rights, which enable historic buildings in certain circumstances to be used for a wider range of alternative purposes.

A copy of the Amending Scheme has been deposited at this office—Geelong Regional Commission, State Government Offices, corner of Little Malop and Fenwick Streets, Geelong, at the offices of the nine municipalities of the Region (insofar as the Municipalities are affected) and at the Offices of the Ministry for Planning and Environment, The Oldersleet Buildings, 477 Collins Street, Melbourne, and will be open for inspection during office hours by any person free of charge.


