Equal Opportunity Act 1984 EXEMPTION

Application No. 3 of 1986

On 26 June 1986, the Equal Opportunity Board considered an application under section 40 (1) of the *Equal Opportunity Act 1984* by Westernport Youth Refuge Inc. for an exemption from the provisions of the Act to enable it to employ a person of a particular sex to fill a vacancy when no person of that sex is on the staff.

The Board had regard to the fact that the applicant had informed the Board that its workers had found that some of the young persons resident in the refuge had difficulty relating to a worker of a particular sex because of past negative experiences with a member or members of that sex, or sensitivity about matters related to their own sex.

The Board determined that in these circumstances it was necessary to ensure that there are members of both sexes on the staff at all times.

The Board hereby grants an exemption from the operation of sections 21 (1) and 59 of the *Equal Opportunity Act 1984* to permit the applicant to employ a person of a particular sex to fill a vacancy for a youth worker when no person of that sex is on the staff.

This exemption shall remain in force until 26 June 1989.

Equal Opportunity Act 1984 EXEMPTION

Application No. 12 of 1986

On 28 August 1986, the Equal Opportunity Board considered an application under section 40 (1) of the *Equal Opportunity Act 1984* by the City of Coburg for renewal of an exemption from the provisions of the Act to enable it to employ a person of a particular sex as a pool attendant at Coburg and Pascoe Vale swimming pools.

The Board had regard to the fact that the applicant had informed the Board that the duties of a pool attendant include entering change rooms and toilets in situations where, for example, a person is ill or has an accident or where it is believed that a person is interfering with another person's property.

The Board determined that in these circumstances it was desirable that there be members of both sexes in attendance at the pools at all times.

The Board hereby grants an exemption from the operation of sections 21 (1) and 59 of the *Equal Opportunity Act 1984* to permit the applicant to employ a person of a particular sex to fill a vacancy for a pool attendant at Coburg and Pascoe Vale swimming pools.

This exemption shall remain in force until 28 August 1989.

Equal Opportunity Act 1984 EXEMPTION

Application No. 13 of 1986

On 28 August 1986, the Equal Opportunity Board considered an application under section 40 (1) of the *Equal Opportunity Act 1984* by the Copelen Street Family Centre for renewal of an exemption from the provisions of the Act to enable it to maintain a suitable balance of the sexes among child care workers at the centre.

The Board had regard to the fact that the applicants had informed the Board that a large number of children who attend the centre come from single parent families where the custodial parent is most often the mother. The children's relationships with males have been mostly negative or destructive and the centre aims to provide them with a positive male model.

The Board determined that in these circumstances it was necessary to ensure that there are members of both sexes on the staff at all times.

The Board hereby grants an exemption from the operation of sections 21 (1) and 59 of the *Equal Opportunity Act 1984* to permit the applicant to employ a person of a particular sex to fill a vacancy for a child care worker when the number of employed workers of that sex falls below two.

The exemption shall remain in force until 28 August 1989.

Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978

Regulations

FERNY CREEK RECREATION RESERVE
FERNY CREEK PRESERVATION OF
NATURAL FEATURES RESERVE

I, Joan Elizabeth Kirner, Her Majesty's Minister for Conservation, Forests and Lands in and for the State of Victoria, in pursuance of the powers conferred on me by section 13 of the *Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978* do hereby make the following regulations for or with respect to:

- (a) the remaining portion of the lands in the Parish of Monbulk temporarily reserved for Public Recreation by Orders in Council of 15 June 1914, 25 September 1928, 21 October 1935 and 30 April 1985 (vide *Government*

Gazettes dated 24 June 1914, 3 October 1928, 23 October 1935 and 8 May 1985 respectively).

- (b) the land in the said Parish temporarily reserved for the Preservation of Natural Features by Order in Council of 6 December 1960 (vide *Government Gazette* dated 14 December 1960), hereinafter referred to as the "Reserves".

The Reserves have been placed under the control of a Committee of Management (hereinafter referred to as the "Committee") with full power and authority to enforce these regulations.

Regulations

1. The Reserves shall be open to the public from sunrise to sunset free of charge, except on such days and on such times as the Committee may, from time to time, determine.

2. No person shall:

- (a) Enter or remain in the Reserves who may offend against decency as regards dress, language or conduct.
- (b) Damage in any way the trees, shrubs, or flowers in the Reserves, nor shall fires be lighted therein, except in properly constructed fireplaces.

No such fires to be permitted on days declared a "Total Fire Ban" under the provision of the *Country Fire Authority Act 1958*.

- (c) Climb or jump over the gates or fences in or around the Reserves, stick bills thereon, or cut names or in any way damage or injure any of the buildings, gates, fences, seats, or trees in the Reserves, nor leave or deposit any glass, paper, or rubbish, except in receptacles provided, nor roll or throw stones or any missiles of any kind therein.
- (d) Park a motor vehicle or motor cycle within the Reserves except at such places as are set apart for that purpose, and any person using any such place for parking a motor vehicle or motor cycle shall, on demand by an authorized officer of the Committee, pay such fee as is from time to time determined by such Committee, in respect of any such vehicle or cycle; for the use of such parking area.
- (e) Put in the Reserves any cattle, horse, sheep, goat, pig, or other animal without the permission of the Committee first obtained. Provided always that the moneys received from such purposes shall be expended in the maintenance and improvement of the Reserves and included in the Annual Financial Report of the Reserves.
- (f) Bring into the Reserves any dog unless controlled by a chain or cord.

- (g) Camp in the Reserves nor erect therein any dwelling, booth or other structure for the purpose of offering for sale any article without the permission of the Committee first obtained.
- (h) Take part in any public entertainment of any sort in the Reserves without the permission of the Committee first obtained.
- (i) Spit or expectorate on the paths or on any structure or erection in the Reserves.
- (j) Bet publicly in any part of the Reserves, and every person infringing this Regulation shall be liable to expulsion from the Reserves on the order of the Committee or by any authorized officer of the Committee.
- (k) Dig or remove any sand, soil, stone or other material from the Reserves.
- (l) Carry or discharge any firearm or air gun in the Reserves.

3. The Committee may set apart any portion of the Reserves for the purposes of any lawful game, amusement, sport, entertainment, or organized picnic, and from time to time grant to any club, or association of clubs, or person, or persons, the use of the ground so set apart, upon such terms and conditions as it may deem to be reasonable and consistent with these Regulations.

4. Persons renting or hiring the Reserves or any portion thereof for any purpose whatsoever, shall pay to the Committee a fee for the use thereof, such fee as determined by the Committee.

5. The Committee shall have full power and authority to impound any animal found trespassing on the Reserves, and shall be taken to be the occupier of the Reserves (with all the power incidental to that status) with the meaning of any law for the time being in force relating to the impounding of cattle.

6. Persons renting or hiring any stand, building, erection, or enclosure on the occasion of any fetes, sports, or other amusement may be required to deposit any sum which the Committee may at any time determine by way of guarantee that due care shall be taken of such stand, building, erection, or enclosure and such Committee in its absolute discretion may make good any damage or injury sustained by such stand, building, erection, or enclosure, or anything contained therein, during such occupancy or hiring, and deduct the cost of making such loss or damage from the sum of money deposited by way of guarantee, and all persons so renting or hiring shall abide by these Regulations and by any order given by the Committee.

7. No person shall bring into the Reserves for sale or distribution any intoxicating liquor unless holding a licence or permit as required pursuant to the provision of the *Liquor Control Act 1968*, and then only in such place or places or portion of the Reserves as may be set apart for the purpose by the Committee.

8. No person, except labourers and workmen employed in the Reserves, shall enter any plots therein which may be enclosed for plantation of young trees or shrubs.

9. All persons within the Reserves shall abide by any direction made by the Committee or its authorized officer with regard to noise level. (Rs 93, Rs 7999).

These regulations are made in lieu of all previous regulations made for or with respect to the Reserves, which are hereby revoked.

Every person who contravenes or fails to comply with these regulations shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in section 13 of the *Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978*.

HERRING ISLAND RESERVE

Regulations

I, Joan Elizabeth Kirner, Her Majesty's Minister for Conservation, Forests and Lands, in and for the State of Victoria, in pursuance of the powers conferred on me by section 13 of the *Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978* do hereby make the following Regulations for or with respect to the Crown land in the Parish of Jika Jika temporarily reserved for Public Purposes by Order in Council dated 7 August 1984 hereinafter referred to as "the Reserve".

The Reserve has been placed under the control of a Committee of Management (hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") with full power and authority to enforce these Regulations.

1. The Reserve shall be open to the public free of charge, except as hereinafter provided.

2. No person shall—

- (a) enter or remain on the Reserve who may offend against decency as regards dress, language or conduct, or who may behave in a disorderly, unseemly or offensive manner, or create or take part in any disturbance;
- (b) enter or remain on the Reserve whilst in a state of intoxication or whilst under the influence of drugs, nor bring into, consume or sell any drugs in the Reserve;
- (c) bring intoxicating liquor thereon without the written permission of the Committee being first obtained;
- (d) stick bills or posters thereon, or cut names on or in any way damage, mark or injure any of the buildings, seats or trees on the Reserve, nor roll or throw stones or any missiles of any kind therein;
- (e) remove, deface or displace any board, plate or fitting, written or printed notice for the exhibition of any Regulations or notice fixed or set up by the Committee on the Reserve;

- (f) light fires on the Reserve except at places as are set apart for such purpose by the Committee within the building, or elsewhere without the written permission of the Committee being first obtained;
- (g) do anything whatever on the Reserve for the purpose of making money without the written permission of the Committee being first obtained;
- (h) take, ride, drive, put, allow to be taken or put on the Reserve any horse, cattle, sheep, goat, pig or other animal, without the written permission of the Committee being first obtained;
- (i) play, practice or engage in any organised game, sport or entertainment on the Reserve at any time without the written permission of the Committee being first obtained;
- (j) take part in any public entertainment of any sort on the Reserve without the written permission of the Committee being first obtained;
- (k) remain on the Reserve or on any property therein when lawfully directed to leave the same by any Bailiff of Crown lands or Members of the Police Force or any authorized officer of the Committee;
- (l) hawk or sell or offer for sale within the Reserve any goods, fruit or merchandise or anything else whatsoever or solicit or gather money thereon;
- (m) kill, wound, trap or snare or attempt to kill, wound, trap or snare any bird or other native game or have any dead bird, native game or the skin or pelt thereof in his possession on the Reserve;
- (n) dig, or remove any sand, soil, stone or other material from the Reserve;
- (o) break, deposit or leave any bottle, glass, tin, can, waste paper, garbage or litter of any kind on the Reserve except in a receptacle provided for that purpose by the Committee;
- (p) bring onto the Reserve any dog;
- (q) camp on the Reserve or in any of the buildings thereon without the written permission of the Committee having been first obtained;
- (r) cut, saw, dig, move or displace any tree, bough, live or dead vegetation, wood or other material which may be in or on the Reserve, without the written permission of the Committee having been first obtained;
- (s) carry or discharge any firearm or air gun on the Reserve;
- (t) plant any tree or vegetation on the Reserve without written authority of the Committee;
- (u) commit any nuisance on the Reserve or in or on any building, structure or erection on the Reserve;
- (v) obstruct, hinder or interfere with any authorized officer or any employee of the committee in the execution of his duty on the Reserve;
- (w) drive any mini-bike, trail bike and similar recreational vehicle on the Reserve.

3. The owner of any horse, sheep, cattle, goat, pig or other animal found on the Reserve without the written authority of the Committee shall be guilty of an offence against these Regulations.

4. If in the opinion of an authorized officer, any person has contravened or failed to comply with any provision of these Regulations then such officer may demand and receive the name and address of such person and any person who refuses when asked by such officer to furnish his name and address shall be deemed to have committed an offence against these Regulations.

5. Every person infringing any of these Regulations may be removed from the Reserve or from any property therein, or directed to forthwith leave the Reserve or such property therein by any officer or employee of the Committee or by any Bailiff of Crown Lands or by any member of the Police Force.

6. The foregoing Regulations shall not restrict any servants, agents or workmen of the Authority in the proper execution of their duty or work in the Reserve (Rs. 12789).

Authorized officer shall mean any person authorized in writing by the Committee or any person authorized to enforce the By Laws of the City of Richmond.

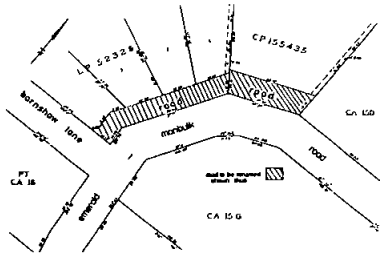
