**Fishing (Scallop) (Amendment No. 3)
Regulations 1987**

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fishing (Scallop)
(Amendment No. 3) Regulations 1987.

Principal Regulations

2. In these Regulations the *Fishing (Scallop) Regulations 1985 are
called the Principal Regulations.

Authorising Provision

3. These Regulations are made under the powers conferred by section 81 of the *Fisheries Act* 1968.

Amendment to the Principal Regulations

4. In Regulation 6 (2) (d) of the Principal Regulations delete:
'for the period 18 May 1986 to 27 March 1987'
