PROCLAMATION OF THE SHIRE OF
WERRIBEE TO BE THE CITY OF WERRIBEE

Whereas Part II of the *Local Government Act* 1958 provides that the Governor in Council may on the recommendation of the Minister for Local Government proclaim a Shire which is substantially urban in character and has a population of not less than 10 000 inhabitants to be a City;

And whereas the Shire of Werribee is substantially urban in character and has a population of not less than 10 000 inhabitants;

Now therefore, I, J. Davis McCaughey, Governor of Victoria acting with the advice of the Executive Council and under Part II of the *Local Government Act* 1958 proclaim the Shire of Werribee to be a City under the name of the City of Werribee with effect on and from 20 March 1987.
