AMBULANCE SERVICES ACT 1986

The Administrator in Council under section 23 of the *Ambulance Services Act 1986* does by this Order:

1. Create ambulance services named—
Ambulance Service Victoria—Metropolitan Region
Ambulance Service Victoria—North Western Region
Ambulance Service Victoria—South Eastern Region

2. Transfer to Ambulance Service Victoria—Metropolitan Region all assets, powers, works, rights, liabilities and obligations of:

(a) Ambulance Service—Melbourne and Peninsula Ambulance Service;

(b) Geelong and District Ambulance Service associated with the Werribee ambulance branch station, including—

- all that land described in Certificate of Title Volume 6698 Folio 852 together with all buildings and improvements thereon;
- three motor vehicles with registration numbers BKM-462, CCS-422 and CZB-320;

(c) Ballarat and District Ambulance Service associated with the Bacchus Marsh and Melton ambulance branch station, including—

- all that land described in Certificate of Title Volume 8326 Folio 269 together with all buildings and improvements thereon;
- all that land described in Certificate of Title Volume 8326 Folio 262 together with all buildings and improvements thereon;
- all that land described in Certificate of Title Volume 9206 Folio 118 together with all buildings and improvements thereon;
- all that land described in Indenture of Conveyance registered in the Office of the Registrar-General No. 235 Book 648 and any Memorial thereof, together with all buildings and improvements thereon;
- four motor vehicles with registration numbers BOD-511, BOD-924, BOD-004 and BQ1-640.

(d) Central Victoria District Ambulance Service associated with the Sunbury ambulance branch station, including—

- two motor vehicles with registration numbers DAN-057 and BPL-006.

(e) Goulburn Valley Ambulance Service associated with the Healesville and Yarra

Junction ambulance branch stations, including—

- all that land described in Certificate of Title Volume 9806 Folio 263 together with all buildings and improvements thereon;
- all that land described in Certificate of Title Volume 7993 Folio 003 together with all buildings and improvements thereon;
- all that land described in Certificate of Title Volume 3772 Folio 208 together with all buildings and improvements thereon;
- five motor vehicles with registration numbers BKH-618, BPO-251, BIS-322, BIS-472 and BJN-377.

and provide that a reference in any document concerned with the matters prescribed above, to the named Ambulance Services shall be construed as a reference to Ambulance Service Victoria—Metropolitan Region.

3. Transfer to Goulburn Valley Ambulance Service all assets, powers, works, rights, liabilities and obligations of Central Victoria District Ambulance Service associated with the Kilmore ambulance branch station, including:

- o all that land described in Indenture of Conveyance registered in the Office of the Registrar-General No. 476 Book 700 and any Memorial thereof, together with all buildings and improvements thereon;
- o two motor vehicles with registration numbers CME-182 and CVA-772;

and provide that a reference in any document concerned with the matters prescribed above, to Central Victoria District Ambulance Service shall be construed as a reference to Goulburn Valley Ambulance Service.

4. Transfer to Wimmera District Ambulance Service all assets, powers, works, rights, liabilities and obligations of Glenelg District Ambulance Service associated with the Edenhope ambulance branch station, including:

- all that land described in Crown Lease Vol. 1208 Folio 933 together with all buildings and improvements thereon;
- two motor vehicles with registration numbers BNF-421 and BNF-423;
- an amount of \$38 508.90 contained in Commonwealth Bank of Australia Term Deposits, Account Identification Numbers 351350017720, 351350018811 and 351350018731;

and provide that a reference in any document concerned with the matters prescribed above, to Glenelg District Ambulance Service shall be construed as a reference to the Wimmera District Ambulance Service.

5. Transfer to Ambulance Service Victoria—North Western Region all assets, powers, works, rights, liabilities and obligations, with the exception of those referred to in paragraphs 2 (d) and 3, of North West Victorian Ambulance Service, Mid Murray District Ambulance Service, Northern District Ambulance Service and Central Victoria District Ambulance Service; and provide that a reference in any document concerned with the matters prescribed above, to the named Ambulance Services shall be construed as a reference to Ambulance Service Victoria—North Western Region.

6. Transfer to Ambulance Service Victoria—South Eastern Region all assets, powers, works, rights, liabilities and obligations of East Gippsland Ambulance Service, Latrobe Valley District Ambulance Service and South Gippsland District Ambulance Service;

and provide that a reference in any document concerned with the matters prescribed above, to the named Ambulance Services shall be construed as a reference to Ambulance Service Victoria—South Eastern Region.

7. Provide for the transfer of employment to Ambulance Service Victoria—Metropolitan Region of:

- (a) all employees of Ambulance Service—Melbourne and Peninsula Ambulance Service;
- (b) Gordon William O'Keeffe; Robert Tull; James Douglas Bartlett; Alexander Leo Drapow; and Daryl Charles Wells; being employees of Geelong and District Ambulance Service;
- (c) Peter Warren Marshman; John Patrick Faulkner; Derek Keith St. Clair Fryer; Henry Ernest Brindley; and Richard James Gough; being employees of Ballarat and District Ambulance Service;
- (d) Bryce Harley Lindemann; and Robert John Marshall; being employees of Central Victoria District Ambulance Service;
- (e) James Murray McGregor; Brian John Purves; Graeme Arthur Sellers; Douglas Ross Graham; and Carl Anthony Frankish; being employees of Goulburn Valley Ambulance Service.

8. Provide for the transfer of employment to Goulburn Valley Ambulance Service of Graeme Robert Williams; Robert John Richardson; and

Daryl Anthony Lee; being employees of Central Victoria District Ambulance Service.

9. Provide for the transfer of employment to Wimmera District Ambulance Service of Richard James Tye; and Samuel Allan Hadden; being employees of Glenelg District Ambulance Service.

10. Provide for the transfer of employment to Ambulance Service Victoria—North Western Region of all employees, with the exception of the persons named in paragraphs 7 (d) and 8 above, of North West Victorian Ambulance Service; Mid Murray District Ambulance Service; Northern District Ambulance Service; and Central Victoria District Ambulance Service.

11. Provide for the transfer of employment to Ambulance Service Victoria—South Eastern Region of all employees of East Gippsland Ambulance Service; Latrobe Valley District Ambulance Service; and South Gippsland District Ambulance Service.

12. Appoint David Rodger Webb as the initial Regional Superintendent of Ambulance Service Victoria—Metropolitan Region.

13. Appoint James Donald Mason as the initial Regional Superintendent of Ambulance Service Victoria—North Western Region.

14. Appoint Douglas Frederick Haynes as the initial Regional Superintendent of Ambulance Service Victoria—South Eastern Region.

15. Specify that the boundaries of the area over which the following ambulance services have administrative jurisdiction are the boundaries of the area occupied by the Municipalities, Parishes and Areas listed respectively:

(a) Ambulance Service Victoria—Metropolitan Region:
the Municipalities of Altona, Bacchus Marsh, Berwick, Box Hill, Brighton, Broadmeadows, Brunswick, Bulla, Camberwell, Caulfield, Chelsea, Coburg, Collingwood, Cranbourne, Croydon, Dandenong, Diamond Valley, Doncaster and Templestowe, Eltham, Essendon, Fitzroy, Flinders, Footscray, Frankston, Hastings, Hawthorn, Healesville, Heidelberg, Keilor, Kew, Knox, Lillydale, Malvern, Melbourne, Melton, Moorabbin, Mordialloc, Mornington, Northcote, Nunawading, Oakleigh, Pakenham, Port Melbourne, Prahran, Preston, Richmond, Ringwood, St. Kilda, Sandringham, Sherbrooke, South Melbourne, Springvale, Sunshine, Waverley, Werribee, Whittlesea, Williamstown and Upper Yarra.

(b) Ambulance Service Victoria—North Western Region:

the Municipalities of Bendigo, Bet Bet, Castlemaine, Charlton, Cohuna, Eaglehawk, East Loddon, Echuca, Gisborne, Gordon, Huntly, Kerang, Kerang (Borough), Korong, Kyneton, McIvor, Maldon, Marong, Maryborough, Metcalfe, Mildura, Mildura (City), Newham and Woodend, Newstead, Pyalong, Rochester, Romsey, Strathfieldsaye, Swan Hill, Swan Hill (City), Tullaroop, Walpeup and Wycheproof,

and that part of the Municipality of Karkaroc comprising the Parishes, or parts thereof, of Patchewollock North, Dering, Tyenna, Patchewollock, Dennyning, and Gorya;

and that part of the Municipality of Deakin comprising the Parishes or parts thereof, of Echuca North, Kanyapella, Echuca South, Koyuga, Nanncella, Timmering, Corop and Carag Carag.

(c) Ambulance Service Victoria—South Eastern Region:

the Municipalities of Alberton, Avon, Bairnsdale, Bairnsdale (Town), Bass, Buln Buln, Korumburra, Maffra, Mirboo, Moe, Morwell, Narracan, Omeo, Orbost, Phillip Island, Rosedale, Sale, South Gippsland, Tambo, Traralgon, Traralgon (City), Warragul, Wonthaggi, and Woorayl, and the Yallourn Works Area and French Island.

(d) Geelong and District Ambulance Service:
the Municipalities of Bannockburn, Barrabool, Bellarine, Colac, Colac (City), Corio, Geelong, Geelong West, Leigh, Newtown, Otway, Queenscliffe, South Barwon, and Winchelsea.

(e) South-Western Victoria Ambulance Service:
the Municipalities of Belfast, Camperdown, Heytesbury, Koroit, Mortlake, Port Fairy, Warrnambool, Warrnambool (City), and Hampden, excepting: the Parishes of Skipton and Borriyalloak, and the Tower Hill Reserve.

(f) Glenelg District Ambulance Service:
the Municipalities of Dundas, Glenelg, Hamilton, Minhamite, Mount Rouse, Portland, Portland (City), and Wannoo.

- (g) Ballarat and District Ambulance Service: the Municipalities of Ararat, Ararat (City), Avoca, Ballan, Ballarat, Ballarat (City), Bungarce, Buninyong, Creswick, Daylesford and Glenlyon, Donald, Grenville, Kara Kara, Lexton, Ripon, St. Arnaud, Sebastopol, Talbot and Clunes, and that part of the Municipality of Hampden comprising the Parishes of Skipton and Borriyalloak.

- (h) Wimmera District Ambulance Service: the Municipalities of Arapiles, Birchip, Dimboola, Dunmunkle, Horsham, Kaniva, Kowree, Lowan, Stawell, Warracknabeal, Wimmera, and Karkaroc, excepting that part comprising the Parishes, or parts thereof, of Patchewollock North, Dering, Tyenna, Patchewollock, Dennyng, and Gorya.

- (i) Goulburn Valley Ambulance Service: the Municipalities of Broadford, Cobram, Euroa, Goulburn, Kilmore, Kyabram, Nathalia, Numurkah, Rodney, Seymour, Shepparton, Shepparton (City), Violet Town, Waranga, and Yea, and that part of the Municipality of Deakin comprising the Parishes, or parts thereof, of Wyuna, Tongala, Taripta, Kyabram, and Girgarre.

- (j) North-Eastern Victoria District Ambulance Service: the Municipalities of Beechworth, Benalla, Benalla (City), Bright, Chiltern, Mansfield, Myrtleford, Oxley, Rutherglen, Tallangatta, Tungamah, Upper Murray, Wangaratta, Wangaratta (City), Wodonga, Yackandandah, and Yarrowonga.

- (k) Alexandra and District Ambulance Service: the Municipality of Alexandra.

16. Abolish the following ambulance services and remove them from the list in Schedule 1 of the Act:

- Ambulance Service—Melbourne
- Central Victoria District Ambulance Service
- East Gippsland District Ambulance Service
- Latrobe Valley District Ambulance Service
- Mid Murray District Ambulance Service
- Northern District Ambulance Service
- North West Victorian Ambulance Service
- Peninsula Ambulance Service
- South Gippsland District Ambulance Service.

17. Specify that the Order comes into operation on 1 July 1987.
