Proposed Regulations Regarding Mussel  
Dredging

In order to reduce possible environmental damage caused by mussel dredging in Port Phillip Bay it is proposed that a new Regulation be made to close the season on 1 November 1987.

It is proposed to re-open the season on 4 April 1988.

A regulatory impact statement (RIS) has been prepared as required by the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1962*.

The RIS concludes that the potential benefits of the Regulations outweigh any likely costs.
