**FISHING (SCALLOP) (AMENDMENT No. 7)

*Citation*

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fishing (Scallop) (Amendment No. 7) Regulations 1987.

*Principal Regulations*

2. In these Regulations the \*Fishing (Scallop) Regulations 1985 are called the Principal Regulations.

*Authorising Provision*

3. These Regulations are made under section 81 of the *Fisheries Act 1968*.

*Amendment of Regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations*

4. For Regulation 4 (1) (b) substitute—  
“(b) at any time after 5 o'clock in the afternoon of the 26 November 1987”.

*Amendment of Regulation 6 of the Principal Regulations*

5. In Regulation 6 (2) (a) for “17 December 1987” substitute “26 November 1987”.

A resources report for the review of public land within the Mallee Area will be available for inspection at the office of the Land Conservation Council from Thursday, 26 November 1987.

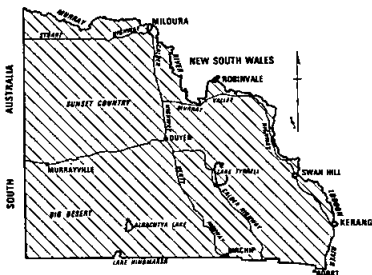

*Industrial Training Act 1975*

*Post-Secondary Education Act 1978*, Part III and so much of the rest of the Act as relates to technical and further education (the remaining provisions are administered by the Minister for Education).

**Minister for Labour**

*Employment and Training Act 1981*, except insofar as it relates to technical and vocational training (these provisions are administered by the Premier); and excluding sections 8 (c) and 15 insofar as they relate to the Victorian Technology Advisory Committee and excluding section 17 (these provisions are administered by the Minister for Industry, Technology and Resources).

**Minister for Education**

*Post-Secondary Education Act 1978*, except for Part III and so much of the rest of the Act as relates to technical and further education (these provisions are administered by the Premier).

**STATE TRAINING BOARD ORDER 1987**

1. This Order is called the State Training Board Order 1987.

2. This Order is made under the powers conferred by section 15A of the *Post-Secondary Education Act 1978*, section 23B of the *Public Service Act 1974* and all other enabling powers.

3. This Order takes effect on and after 30 November 1987.

4. The purpose of this Order is to establish an Authority to co-ordinate and administer the Government's training policies and the technical and vocational training services provided by the State and its public authorities.

5. A State Training Board is established.

6. (1) The State Training Board shall consist of not more than ten members appointed by the Governor in Council, of whom—

(a) one must be appointed as Chairperson,

(b) two must be persons who have experience as employers or members of employer groups

- (c) two must be trade union officials
- (d) one must be an officer of the Technical and Further Education Teaching Service nominated by the Technical Teachers' Union of Victoria,
- (e) one must be a Chairperson of a TAFE Regional Board.

(2) Subject to sub-clause (3), members of the State Training Board are entitled to receive the remuneration and travelling and other allowances fixed from time to time by the Governor in Council.

(3) Members who are officers or employees of the Public Service or the Technical and Further Education Teaching Service are not entitled to receive remuneration.

7. Schedule Two of the *Public Service Act 1974* is amended by:

- (a) removing the associated administrative unit of "Office of the Technical and Further Education Board" from column three;
- (b) removing the name of the office of the "Chairman, Technical and Further Education Board" from column four;
- (c) adding, in relation to the administrative unit of "Department of the Premier and Cabinet" in column one, the unit of "Office of the State Training Board" to column three immediately after the unit of "Office of the Governor"; and
- (d) adding, in relation to the unit of "Office of the State Training Board" in column three, the office of "General Manager, State Training Board" to column four.

8. The functions of the Office of the State Training Board are:

- (a) to identify major Industry Foundations which are necessary to be established for key sectors identified in the Economic Strategy and to:
  - obtain industry and Commonwealth Government funding for training
  - develop more effective training in those sectors
  - increase the avenues for entry to recognised skills, and
  - improve articulation between industry training and educational studies.

- (b) to ensure that all apprentices are placed in appropriate training; to increase the output from that training; to reduce the per capita costs and maximise self-paced learning; and to establish for all apprenticeships competency standards and competency testing.
- (c) to increase the participation of disadvantaged groups in recognised post-school education and training.
- (d) to develop and achieve industry recognition of schemes for training and retraining adults.
- (e) to increase the number and effectiveness of Industry Skill Centres to ensure that these centres contribute in a substantial way to gaining greater industry support for training.
- (f) to establish cross-crediting arrangements between the VCE and apprenticeships and between the VCE and traineeships.
- (g) to strengthen the links between TAFE Colleges and community providers and increase the education and training options of adults seeking entry to the workforce through those means.
- (h) to develop traineeships and cadetships as widely recognised methods for training and retraining.
- (i) to assist the Minister in the administration of the *Post-Secondary Education Act 1978*, the *Employment and Training Act 1981* and the *Industrial Training Act 1975*.
- (j) to carry out such of the powers and function of the Victorian Post-Secondary Education Commission as are delegated pursuant to section 15A of the *Post-Secondary Education Act 1978*
- (k) to assist and advise in the development of, and to implement, policies determined by the Government, the Minister and the State Training Board
- (l) to provide a Secretary of the Industrial Training Commission and all of the staff of the Office of the State Training Board as the officers and employees to carry out the functions of the Industrial Training Commission and to assist the Technical and Further Education Board.



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
