Declaration of Fire Danger Period

In pursuance of the powers conferred by section 4 of the *Country Fire Authority Act 1958*, I, Steven Marshall Crabb, Minister for Police and Emergency Services, after consultation with the Minister for Conservation, Forests and Lands hereby declare the following periods to be the fire danger periods in the municipalities or parts of municipalities specified, commencing on the date shown and, unless varied by subsequent declaration, ending at midnight on Saturday, 30 April 1988:

To commence from and inclusive of Monday, 21 December 1987.
