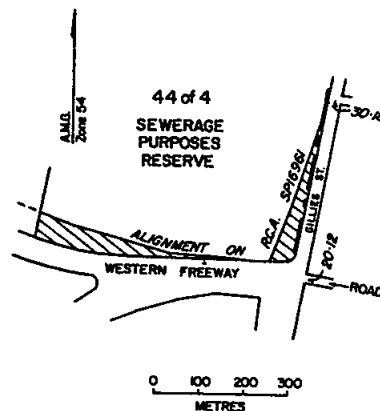

Whereas by an Order in Council dated 13 June 1984 made under the provisions of the *Water and Sewerage Authorities (Restructuring) Act 1983* and published in the *Victoria Government Gazette* on 13 June 1984, the Governor in Council constituted a Water Board under the corporate name of Violet Town Water Board.

And whereas by an Order in Council dated 19 February 1985 made under the provisions of the *Water and Sewerage Authorities (Restructuring) Act 1983* and published in the *Victoria Government Gazette* on 27 February 1985, the Governor in Council constituted a Water Board under the corporate name of Shepparton Water Board.

And whereas the Violet Town Water Board and the Shepparton Water Board have made a

joint application under section 13 (3) of the *Water and Sewerage Authorities (Restructuring) Act 1983* to the Minister for Water Resources for the transfer of certain lands, easements, works, property, powers, rights, liabilities and obligations from the Violet Town Water Board to the Shepparton Water Board and for the abolition of the Violet Town Water Board.

And whereas under the provisions of section 12 of the said Act, the Governor in Council, on the recommendation of the Minister for Water Resources, may make an order to give effect to such an application.

Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, on the recommendation of the Minister for Water Resources, in pursuance of the hereinbefore recited powers, doth hereby declare, order and direct that:

A. There shall be transferred from the Violet Town Water Board to the Shepparton Water Board as on and from 1 October 1987 (hereinafter called "the operative date"):

- (a) (i) all property, plant equipment and works used or intended to be used by the Violet Town Water Board for the storage and distribution of water, together with all interests, rights, benefits and advantages owned by vested in, possessed by or accruing to the Violet Town Water Board in relation thereto;
- (ii) all rights and liabilities in land or easements owned by, vested in, or existing in favour of the Violet Town Water Board including any lands or easements in the process of being acquired as at the operative date;
- (iii) all powers, obligations and rights of the Violet Town Water Board in relation to the supply by it of water.

(b) The ownership of all the works of water supply hereinbefore described.

B. There shall be transferred the liabilities of the Violet Town Water Board to the Shepparton Water Board by transferring as on and from the operative date the amounts shown in the books of the Violet Town Water Board at that date to the Shepparton Water Board to the intent that such amounts shall be, as on and from the operative date, the responsibility of the Shepparton Water Board.

C. All loans made or the balance of such loans available as at the operative date to the Violet Town Water Board be taken over by the Shepparton Water Board on the terms and

conditions applying to such loans immediately prior to the operative date.

D. All monies due and payable to the Violet Town Water Board as at the operative date, in respect of the supply of water shall by this Order, and as on and from the operative date, be due and payable to the Shepparton Water Board.

E. The boundaries of the following Districts, as such boundaries apply as at the operative date, shall be the boundaries of the additional districts over which the Shepparton Water Board is to have jurisdiction as on and from the operative date and such districts shall continue to be known by their present names;

Violet Town Waterworks District

Violet Town Urban District

F. The electoral district of the Shepparton Water Board is to be extended by adding thereto the area contained within the Violet Town Waterworks District as on and from the operative date.

G. The Violet Town Water Board shall be abolished as on and from the operative date.

Boilers and Pressure Vessels Act 1970

ORDER OF EXEMPTION No. 21

The Governor in Council, under section 4 of the *Boilers and Pressure Vessels Act 1970* makes the following order:

1. This order relates to boilers and pressure vessels to be operated at the National Steam Rally at Lake Goldsmith, Victoria from 17 October 1987 to 14 November 1987 inclusive.

2. Any boiler or pressure vessel which is brought into the State of Victoria from elsewhere

in Australia is exempted from Parts II, III, IV and V and sections 27 (2), 30, 31 and 32 of the said Act if used exclusively in relation to the undertaking noted in clause one:

Provided that the said boiler or pressure vessel—

- (a) fully complies with all of the requirements for such boiler or pressure vessel applicable in its state of origin;
- (b) is the subject of a current certificate of inspection issued by the Statutory Authority in its state of origin;
- (c) is operated by a person holding an appropriate certificate of competency issued by the Statutory Authority in its state of origin.

3. A certificate issued by the Statutory Authority referred to in paragraph (b) in clause 2 may be issued for a period not longer than 12 months and shall include a certification by an authorised officer of the Statutory Authority that the boiler or pressure vessel—

- (a) has been inspected; and
- (b) is in a safe and proper condition for use.

4. The maximum allowable working pressure for the boiler or pressure vessel must be included in the certification referred to in clause 3.

5. The owner or operator of the boiler or pressure vessel shall produce to the organiser of the National Steam Rally or an Inspector of Boilers and Pressure Vessels on demand the certificate issued in respect to that boiler or pressure vessel or operator under the provisions of clause 3 and clause 2 (c).
