ORDERING PROCEDURES

Ordering procedure and general information on Contractors.

1. AMI Toyota Limited—Contract No. 1988/89—1037.

Ordering Procedure:

Orders must be made out to: Fleet Department, AMI Toyota Limited, 44 White Street, South Melbourne 3205 (Telephone 647 8828) Fax 647 8844. Orders must clearly state the model of the vehicle ordered, details of all options required, delivery address, registration number and price agreed for trade-in vehicle. Vehicle will be delivered through a Toyota dealer nominated by AMI Toyota Limited.

Payment of Accounts:

AMI Toyota Limited will invoice the relative government department, for the cost of vehicle or the changeover price where a trade-in is involved. The cost of third party insurance and any other statutory charges applicable will be invoiced separately after the vehicle has been delivered. Payment is required within 30 days of receipt of vehicle.

Delivery Time:

Maximum delivery time from receipt of order is 30 days.

Delivery Charges:

Included in contract rate.

Price Protection:

The price charged will be the contract price applying at the date of placement of the order.

Warranty:

12 months/20 000 km.

2. Ford Sales Company of Australia Ltd.—Contract No. 1988/89—1038.

Ordering Procedure:

Orders are to be placed direct with a Ford dealer. A copy of the order must be forwarded to:

A delivering dealer should be nominated on the order.

ORDERING PROCEDURES—continued

Payment of Accounts:

Payment within 30 days of receipt of invoice, provided the vehicle has been received and is acceptable.

Delivery Time:

Maximum time from receipt of order is 12 working weeks. The delivery time stated does not allow for industrial action which may delay the build or delivery of the vehicle.

Delivery Charges:

Included in contract rate.

Price Protection:

In the event of a price variation, the price charged for the vehicle will be that price ruling at date of order, provided a copy of the order is received at, and accepted by Ford Southern Regional Office within seven days of date of order.

Warranty:

12 months/20 000 km.

3. Holden's Motor Co.—Contract No. 1988/89—1039.

Ordering Procedure:

Vehicles must be ordered direct from a Holden's Motor Company dealer.

A copy of the order must be forwarded to:

Payment of Accounts:

Payment within 30 days of receipt of vehicle is to be made to delivering dealer.

Delivery Time:

Maximum time from receipt of order is 10–12 weeks.

Delivery Charges:

Included in contract rate.

Price Protection:

HMC will price protect all orders received as from the date of acceptance of those orders by HMC until delivery (ex Plant of build) except where the delivery of the order is delayed beyond 13 weeks by:

1. Factors which delay HMC suppliers deliveries to HMC, caused by circumstances beyond the control of HMC; and/or
2. Delays caused by industrial disruptions or shortages at HMC's Plants; and/or
3. The purchaser placing an order which does not give HMC sufficient time (13 weeks) in which to fulfil that order prior to plant closedown.

Warranty:

12 months/20 000 km.

4. Mitsubishi Motors Australia Ltd—Contract No. 1988/89—1040.

Ordering Procedure:

Vehicles must be ordered direct from a Mitsubishi dealer.

Payment of Accounts:

Payment within 30 days of delivery of vehicle is to be made to the delivering dealer.

Delivery Time:

Maximum time for delivery of vehicle from receipt of order—8 weeks.

Delivery Charges:

Included in contract rate.

Price Protection:

The price charged will be the contract price applying at the date of placement of order.

Warranty:

12 months/unlimited kilometres.

Item Nos. 1 and 2—24 months/40 000 km additional cost \$40.

Item Nos. 7, 8, 11 and 12—24 months/40 000 km additional cost \$50.

ORDERING PROCEDURES—continued

5. Nissan Motor Co. (Aust.) Pty. Ltd.—Contract No. 1988/89—1041.

Ordering Procedure:

Vehicles must be ordered direct from a Nissan dealer.

Payment of Accounts:

Payment within 30 days of receipt of vehicle is to be made to delivering dealer.

Delivery Time:

Maximum time from receipt of order is 60 days.

Price Protection:

The price charged will be the contract price applying at the date of placement of orders. However, where a government department nominates a delivery date on an order which exceeds Nissan's maximum nominated delivery time of 60 days from date of order then the price charged will be the contract price applying at date of delivery.

Delivery Charges:

Included in contract rate.

Warranty:

24 months/40 000 kms.

PURCHASING INFORMATION

Purchases (Departments Only)—Motor vehicles are to be purchased in accordance with instructions issued by the Director, Victorian Government Motor Vehicle Fleet as outlined in Standard Policies and Procedures Manual.

Rates—The rates tendered do not include sales tax and are subject to "rise and fall". Departments etc. shall be notified of all authorised variations.

Delivery Charges—Where applicable these are specified.

Optional Equipment—Details of optional equipment available but not included in the base cost of the vehicle are listed for each class of vehicle.

Dealers—Details of authorised vehicle dealers are available from the Director, Victorian Government Motor Vehicle Fleet.

Conditions of Contract—Extracts from the conditions of contract are shown below for the guidance of officers ordering and receiving vehicles. Full details are contained in this periodical:

1. The price of a contract motor vehicle shall include all equipment and services as specified in the specification hereto regardless of whether the extras specified are fitted by the Contractor or by a dealer. (Clause 4.3.)

2. A contract motor vehicle supplied to a Purchaser shall be the current model. (Clause 6.1.)

3. The compliance plate on a contract motor vehicle supplied to the Purchaser shall be dated not more than three (3) months prior to the date of delivery and without limiting the generality of the terms and conditions herein where the date exceeds three (3) months a Purchaser may seek an appropriate discount from the Contractor or may reject the vehicle. (Clause 6.2.)

4. The Contractor shall give the Purchaser 48 hours' notice of delivery of a contract motor vehicle to the specified address for delivery. (Clause 9.3.)

5. The Contractor shall arrange for the dealer at no additional cost to the Purchaser to give the contract motor vehicle a thorough pre-delivery check in accordance with the instructions of the Contractor prior to delivery of the contract motor vehicle to the Purchaser. (Clause 9.7.)

6. The Contractor shall provide to the Purchaser evidence to verify that the Contractor's pre-delivery checklist has been satisfactorily carried out. (Clause 9.8.)

7. Where satisfactory evidence of the carrying out of pre-delivery check is not provided by the Contractor to the Purchaser, the Purchaser may refuse to accept the vehicle. (Clause 9.9.)

8. The Contractor shall supply to the Purchaser not less than ten (10) litres of fuel in the fuel tank of the vehicle. (Clause 9.10.)

9. The Contractor shall be responsible for the safe transport of the contract motor vehicle and for any damage occasioned to the contract motor vehicle during delivery to the Purchaser. (Clause 9.13.)

10. The Contractor shall be liable for any damage to property of the Purchaser occasioned by the Contractor or any person engaged by the Contractor during the delivery of any contract motor vehicle or the performance of any service required under the contract. (Clause 20.)

PURCHASING INFORMATION—continued

11. The Purchaser shall be deemed to have accepted a contract motor vehicle when an authorised officer intimates to the Contractor that it has accepted the contract motor vehicle or when after the lapse of thirty (30) days it retains the contract motor vehicle without intimating to the Contractor that it has rejected the contract motor vehicle. (Clause 10.1.)

12. Except where otherwise stated in the order the Contractor shall register the contract motor vehicle prior to delivery in accordance with the instructions issued by the Purchaser and the Contractor shall be reimbursed by the Purchaser for the cost of registration. (Clause 11.1.)

13. On site police inspection fees in relation to contract motor vehicles shall not be charged to the Purchaser. (Clause 11.2.)

14. The Contractor shall invoice the Purchaser for the expenses of registration at the time of delivery of the vehicle to the Purchaser together with satisfactory evidence that the sums claimed have been disbursed. (Clause 11.3.)

STATE TENDER BOARD**CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY
OF MOTOR VEHICLES****1. Definitions:**

1.1 "Board" means the State Tender Board.

1.2 "Contract" means the contract to which these conditions have been attached.

1.3 "Contract Price" means the price the Board has accepted for the supply of Stores or the price of the Stores as varied by the Board in accordance with these Conditions of Contract for Motor Vehicles.

1.4 "Contract Motor Vehicle" means the motor vehicle specified in the contract.

1.5 "Contractor" means the party specified in the contract as the "Contractor".

1.6 "Order" means a requirement in writing from the Purchaser to supply any of the stores which are subject to the Contract.

1.7 "Month" shall mean calendar month.

1.8 "Dealer" means a person nominated by the Contractor in his tender pursuant to sub-clauses 12.3 and 14.1 of the "Conditions of Tender".

1.9 "Person" shall include a corporation.

1.10 "Schedule" means the Schedule (of which these conditions form part of) to the contract.

1.11 "Purchaser" includes the Crown in right of the State of Victoria and any State Government Instrumentality or State Government Authority approved by the Board.

1.12 "Stores" means goods, supplies and requisitions and where the context so admits or requires, services.

1.13 Masculine gender shall be deemed and taken to include females, and the singular to include the plural, and the plural the singular.

2. Description of Motor Vehicles:

2.1 A Contract Motor Vehicle shall comply with the Australian Standard Specification and Australian Design Rules, save as provided in the specifications hereto.

2.2 A Contract Motor Vehicle shall comply with the specifications hereto.

3. Supply of Motor Vehicles:

3.1 during the contract period a Contract Motor Vehicle may be ordered by—

- (a) any State Government Department; or
- (b) any State Government Instrumentality approved by the Board—

and shall be supplied by the Contractor or Dealer as the case may be in accordance with the terms and conditions herein.

3.2 Where the Contractor nominates a Dealer to supply, sell and deliver Contract Motor Vehicles during the contract period on its behalf the Dealer shall for all purposes be deemed to act as the agent of the Contractor.

4. Price:

4.1 A Contract Motor Vehicle and accessories shall be supplied by the Contractor to the Purchaser at the price specified by the Contractor in its tender.

4.2 The price at which a Contract Motor Vehicle shall be sold to a Purchaser shall be the Contract Price applying at the date of the placement of the Order by the Purchaser.

4.3 The price of a Contract Motor Vehicle shall include all equipment and services as specified in the specification hereto regardless of whether the extras specified are fitted by the Contractor or by a Dealer.

4.4 A Purchaser may order and acquire any option offered by the Contractor but not included in its accepted tender, at the same discount as specified by a Contractor for the options referred to in the schedules hereto.

5. Price Variations:

5.1 The Contract Price shall be firm unless otherwise stated in the Contract.

CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT—*continued*

5.2 Where a Contractor has included a provision for a variation in the Contract Price of a Contract Motor Vehicle in his tender, no variation in the price shall be made by the Contractor unless first approved by the Board. The Board may on application by the Contractor approve a variation in the price of the Contract Motor Vehicle in whole or in part.

5.3 The submission by a Contractor of a price variation circular to the Board shall not be accepted by the Board as sufficient application for the purpose of Clause 5.2.

5.4 An application by a Contractor for a variation in the price of a Contract Motor Vehicle shall be supported by all necessary documents verifying the cost variations and other matters relied on.

5.5 The Board may make such inquiries as it sees fit to verify any wage, material or other cost variation relied on.

5.6 Where an application for a variation in the price of a Contract Motor Vehicle is approved by the Board the variation shall take effect 14 days from the date of application for variation, provided that where documents in support of an application for a price variation are not submitted with the application the effective date of the variation shall be 14 days from the date of the submission of satisfactory supporting documents.

5.7 Notwithstanding the foregoing the Board may in its absolute discretion grant or refuse a claim for a price variation in whole or in part.

5.8 The Board may if it sees fit terminate this supply contract upon an application for a price variation.

5.9 The Board shall not publish details of an approved variation in price of a Contract Motor Vehicle prior to the effective date.

6. *Date of Manufacture:*

6.1 A Contract Motor Vehicle supplied to a Purchaser shall be the current model.

6.2 The compliance plate on a Contract Motor Vehicle supplied to the Purchaser shall be dated not more than three (3) months prior to the date of delivery and without limiting the generality of the terms and conditions herein where the date exceeds three (3) months, a Purchaser may seek an appropriate discount from the Contractor or may reject the vehicle/s.

7. *Change of Model or Vehicle Specification:*

7.1 The Contractor shall state its ability to give prior written notice to the Board in the event of any model or specification change that may take place during the contract period and the time in which such notice shall be given.

7.2 Where a specification change occurs in a Contract Motor Vehicle the Contractor shall

advise the Board by letter specifying the changes of significance to the vehicle operator including changes in engine capacity power and types.

7.3 A submission of a Contractor's brochure will not be accepted by the Board as sufficient notification in writing.

7.4 The Board may in its absolute discretion approve and accept a change in specification of a Contract Motor Vehicle. The Board may if it sees fit terminate any supply contract upon a notification of a change in specification of a Contract Motor Vehicle.

8. *Ordering of Vehicles:*

8.1 Except where definite quantities are specified the Purchaser shall not be bound to order from the Contractor all the motor vehicles enumerated in the Schedule, but only those motor vehicles, and such quantities of those motor vehicles as it may be found necessary to order.

8.2 Orders shall be issued by the Purchaser as and when required over the period of this contract.

8.3 The Purchaser reserves the right to purchase otherwise than from the Contractor any of the items enumerated in the Schedule, the purchase of which is, in the opinion of the Board, necessary in order to meet special circumstances or special requirements.

9. *Delivery of Vehicles:*

9.1 Transportation, delivery charges, pre-delivery charges or related costs shall not be charged to the Purchaser by the Contractor or Dealer.

9.2 The Contractor shall deliver to the Purchaser not less than two complete sets of keys for the Contract Motor Vehicle.

9.3 The Contractor shall give the Purchaser 48 hours notice of delivery of a Contract Motor Vehicle to the specified address for delivery.

9.4 Where delivery commitments under the Contract cannot be maintained, the Board shall be immediately informed of the same by the Contractor.

9.5 Where delivery commitments under the Contract cannot be maintained, the Board may in its sole discretion terminate the contract.

9.6 Where the Contractor refuses to deliver a Contract Motor Vehicle in response to an Order issued by the Purchaser, the Board may terminate the Contract.

9.7 The Contractor shall arrange for the Dealer at no additional cost to the Purchaser to give the Contract Motor Vehicle a thorough pre-delivery check in accordance with the instructions of the Contractor prior to delivery of the Contract Motor Vehicle to the Purchaser.

CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT—*continued*

9.8 The Contractor shall provide to the Purchaser evidence to verify that the Contractor's pre-delivery checklist has been satisfactorily carried out.

9.9 Where satisfactory evidence of the carrying out of a pre-delivery check is not provided by the Contractor to the Purchaser, the Purchaser may refuse to accept the Contract Motor Vehicle.

9.10 The Contractor shall supply to the Purchaser not less than ten litres of fuel in the fuel tank of a Contract Motor Vehicle.

9.11 A Contract Motor Vehicle may only be accepted by a duly authorised officer of the Purchaser.

9.12 Where delivery of a Contract Motor Vehicle is delayed for more than thirty (30) days after the delivery date specified in the order, the Purchaser may cancel the Order.

9.13 The Contractor shall be responsible for the safe transport of the Contract Motor Vehicle and for any damage occasioned to the Contract Motor Vehicle during delivery to the Purchaser.

10. *Acceptance of Vehicles:*

10.1 The Purchaser shall be deemed to have accepted a Contract Motor Vehicle when an authorised officer intimates to the Contractor that it has accepted the Contract Motor Vehicle or when after the lapse of thirty (30) days it retains the Contract Motor Vehicle without intimating to the Contractor that it has rejected the Contract Motor Vehicle.

10.2 The Purchaser may reject a Contract Motor Vehicle which does not comply with the terms and conditions of this Contract or where there is a breach of warranty or a condition by the Contractor.

10.3 Property shall not pass in a Contract Motor Vehicle until it has been accepted by the Purchaser.

11. *Registration of New Vehicles:*

11.1 Except where otherwise stated in the Order the Contractor shall register the Contract Motor Vehicle prior to delivery in accordance with the instructions issued by the Purchaser and the Contractor shall be reimbursed by the Purchaser for the cost of registration.

11.2 On site police inspection fees in relation to Contract Motor Vehicles shall not be charged to the Purchaser.

11.3 The Contractor shall invoice the Purchaser for the expenses of registration at the time of the delivery of the vehicle to the Purchaser together with satisfactory evidence that the sums claimed have been disbursed.

12. *Payments:*

12.1 The Purchaser shall pay for a Contract Motor Vehicle in accordance with the terms of

payment specified by the Contractor in his tender.

12.2 Where specific creditor's terms are not positively stated in writing and accepted by the Board the following terms of payment shall apply:

"Settlement of accounts payable is scheduled to occur no later than 30 days after the end of the month in which a correctly rendered invoice is received provided that the goods have been received or services rendered prior to the receipt of the invoice.

Where goods are received or services rendered after a correctly rendered invoice is received, payment will be scheduled to occur no later than 30 days after the end of the month in which the goods were received or the services were rendered."

13. *Spare Parts Availability:*

13.1 The Contractor shall maintain in the State of Victorian full stocks of replacement parts to service the Contract Motor Vehicle.

13.2 Where the Contractor fails to satisfy the requirements of clause 13.1 the Board may terminate the Contract.

14. *Bankruptcy etc. of Contractor:*

Where a Contractor—

14.1 assigns or sublets the Contract, or any part thereof, or assigns or mortgages, charges, or encumbers, attempts to assign, mortgage, charge, or encumber all or any of the moneys payable or to become payable under the Contract, or any other benefit whatsoever arising or which may arise under the Contract, without the consent in writing of the Board first being obtained; or

14.2 being an individual becomes bankrupt; or

14.3 being a corporation enters into voluntary or compulsory liquidation; or

14.4 makes an assignment of his estate for the benefit of his creditors, or makes an arrangement or composition with his creditors—

then and in every such case the Board shall be entitled by notice in writing to terminate the Contract forthwith but without prejudice to any right of action or remedy which shall have accrued or which shall accrue thereafter in favour of the State of Victoria.

15. *Termination:*

15.1 Should the Contractor fail to comply with any of these Conditions of Contract for Motor Vehicles, special conditions, or other specifications which form part of the Contract the Board may by notice in writing served on the Contractor specify the alleged non-compliance

CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT—continued

and may require that it be rectified within a stipulated time after service of the notice ("Notice of Default").

Where Notice of Default has been served and non-compliance has not been remedied within the time stipulated in the Notice of Default the Board in writing may give notice of termination and upon such notice being given the Contract shall be terminated in accordance with the following provisions:

15.1.1 All Orders by Purchasers received by the Contractor after termination shall be returned to the Purchaser;

15.1.2 All Orders received by the Contractor prior to the notice of termination shall be completed in accordance with these Conditions of Contract for Motor Vehicles, special conditions and the specifications relating thereto.

15.2 All damages and expenses incurred under or by virtue of the provisions of Condition 14 or Condition 15.1 shall be ascertained and certified to by the Purchaser and shall be deducted from any money that may be then due, or may thereafter become due to the Contractor, or that may have been deposited by him as a security in respect of the Contract. If the money then due, or thereafter becoming due to the Contractor, or deposited by him aforesaid shall be not sufficient for that purposes, the balance remaining unpaid shall be a debt by the Contractor to the State of Victoria and may be recovered from the Contractor in any Court of competent jurisdiction.

16. Disputes:

Any dispute about the Contract Motor Vehicle, whether as to type, quantity, quality, delay in delivery or any other matter whatsoever in respect of or connected with the Contract shall be determined by the Board and its decision shall be final and binding upon the Contractor. If the Board considers it necessary so to do, it may refer to a "technically qualified person" any Contract Motor Vehicle the Purchaser considers to be not in accordance with the Contract. The decision of "technically qualified person" shall be final and binding upon both parties, and the expenses of such reference shall be paid by the party against whom the decision is given.

17. Service of Notices:

Any notice, consent or approval or other communication to be given to or served upon the Contractor under the Contract shall be deemed to have been duly given or served if it is in writing signed for and on behalf of the Board and either delivered by hand or posted in a letter addressed to the Contractor at his usual or last

known place of business or (in the case of the Contractor being a Company) at its registered office or usual place of business and any notice acknowledgement or other communication to be given or served by the Contractor under the Contract shall be deemed to have been duly given or served if it is in writing signed by or on behalf of the Contractor and is either delivered by hand or posted in a letter addressed to the Board at its address shown in the Contract.

18. Security:

Where the Contractor fails to observe a term or condition of the Contract the Board may forfeit the whole or any part of any security provided by the Contractor.

19. Return of Sales Information:

The Contractor shall at the expiration of each period of six months from the commencement of the Contract furnish a return to the Board setting out details of all sales of Contract Motor Vehicles made to Purchasers during the six month period.

20. Property Damage:

The Contractor shall be liable for any damage to property of the Purchaser occasioned by the Contractor or any person engaged by the Contractor during the delivery of any Contract Motor Vehicle or the performance of any service required under the Contract.

21. Conditions of Labour:

Every person engaged in the performance of the Contract shall be paid such wages and employed subject to such labour conditions as are or may be determined by the relevant award of the Australian Conciliation and Arbitration Commission or the relevant award of the State Conciliation and Arbitration Board or Industrial Relations Commission of Victoria.

22. Disclosure of Information:

22.1 The Board retains a discretionary right whether to disclose successful tender details and prices or not.

22.2 The fact that the Contractor has been successful in obtaining the Contract shall not be the subject of any advertisement by the Contractor.

23. Governing Law:

The Contract shall be subject to and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Victoria.
