*Hospitals and Charities Act 1958*  
AMALGAMATION OF AUSTIN HOSPITAL  
AND ROYAL TALBOT GENERAL  
REHABILITATION HOSPITAL

The Governor in Council makes this order under sections 29, 30 and 42 of the *Hospitals and Charities Act 1958*:

1. Under section 25 of the *Hospitals and Charities Act 1958* the Chief General Manager of the Health Department Victoria has recommended to the Minister for Health that the Austin Hospital and the Royal Talbot General Rehabilitation Hospital be amalgamated.

2. The Governor in Council—

(a) determines that the institutions be amalgamated;

(b) specifies 7 April 1988 as the date on and from which the consequences of amalgamation shall follow;

(c) specifies the Austin Hospital as the new name of the corporation;

(d) approves cancellation of registration of the institutions.
