**NOTICE OF FIXING TOTAL ALLOWABLE
CATCH FOR DECLARED ABALONE
ZONES**

Under section 13C (3) of the *Fisheries Act 1968*, and after having regard to the recommendation of the Fisheries Management Committee, I hereby fix the Total Allowable Catch for abalone in the following declared zones of the abalone fishery for the twelve months from 1 April 1988 as follows:

Eastern Zone—460 tonnes
Central Zone—700 tonnes
Western Zone—280 tonnes

**DECLARED ABALONE LICENCES—
EASTERN AND CENTRAL ZONES**

The Governor in Council, under section 13A (1A) of the *Fisheries Act 1968*, and on the advice of the Minister for Conservation, Forests and Lands who has had regard to the recommendation of the Fisheries Management Committee, declares that abalone licences endorsed for the central zone, the eastern zone, or for both zones, are declared abalone licences.
