Statement

In accordance with the provisions of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1962, notice is given of the proposal to make Regulations to be known as the Port of Melbourne Authority (Amendment) Regulations 1988.

A regulatory impact statement has been prepared as required by the Subordinate Legislation Act 1962.

The object of the Regulations is to include in the Port of Melbourne Authority (No. 2) Regulations 1988, certain regulations found in the Marine Regulations 1985, which are to be repealed with the proclamation of the Marine

These amending Regulations ensure that the Port of Melbourne Authority has adequate control over shipping movement, navigation, vehicles and vessels within the ports to the east of the Port of Melbourne, which ports are to be known as the "associated ports".

The regulatory impact statement concludes that this can only be achieved by making the proposed regulations.

Comments and submissions are invited from the public and will be received up to 21 days from the date of the publication of this notice.
