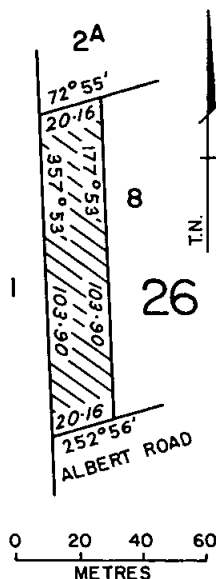

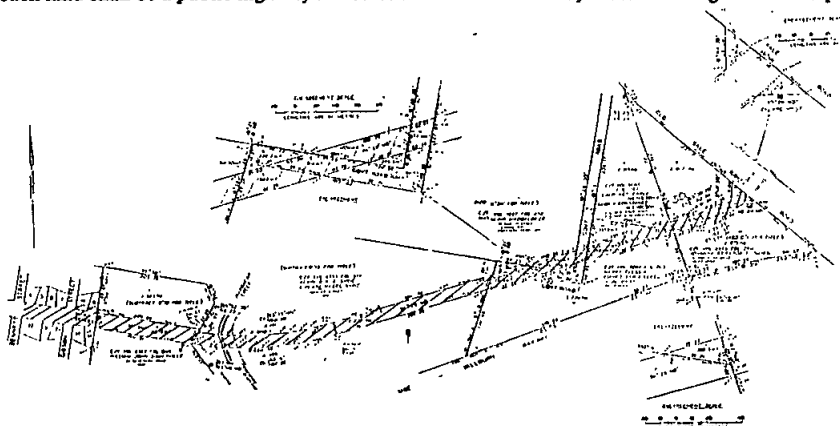

- (c) carry or use any trap, snare, net or other device for the capture of animals;
- (d) disturb, interfere with or destroy any bird or other animal or its lair or nest;
- (e) interfere with, mark, deface, or damage any buildings, gates, fences, barriers, seats, signs or other improvements.

- (f) leave or deposit any glass bottle, tin can, waste paper, refuse or any other rubbish except in receptacles provided for the purpose;
- (g) sell or offer to sell or hire any article or commodity;
- (h) allow any dog to enter or remain unless adequately controlled;
- (i) camp.

3. In the Reserve no person shall, unless authorised by consent in writing of the Committee:

- (a) interfere with, mark, deface or damage, pick or injure any tree, shrub, flower, plant or any other vegetation;
- (b) light or cause to be lit any fire except in any properly constructed fireplace provided for that purpose;
- (c) drive any vehicle including trail bikes, mini bikes and dune buggies except for the purpose of maintaining or installing pumps and pump lines;
- (d) put or allow to remain any sheep, horses, cattle, pigs or other animals;
- (e) organise or take part in any public entertainment, game or sport;
- (f) disturb or remove any soil, sand, gravel or rock;
- (g) erect buildings, power lines, pipelines or other structures.

4. A person who contravenes or fails to comply with any provisions of these regulations shall be guilty of an offence and liable to the penalty prescribed by the Act (Rs. 10499).

#### Garbage Collection By-law

Notice is hereby given that all meetings held on 16 June 1986 and 16 September 1986 the Council made, passed and confirmed a By-law which was approved by the Governor in Council on 16 February 1988 intituled.

A By-law of the Shire of Waranga made under the provisions of the *Health Act 1958* (as amended) with the approval of the Governor in Council and numbered 120 for the purpose of:

- (a) The provision use and control of receptacles for the deposit and collection of refuse and rubbish;
- (b) Preventing or regulating the deposit of refuse upon the streets and other lands and places under the control of the Council;

- (c) The removal replacement cleansing and disinfecting of receptacles for refuse; and the use of deodorants or disinfectants in such receptacles.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Health Act 1958*, and in pursuance of all other powers it thereunto enabling the President, Councillors and Ratepayers of the Shire of Waranga order as follows:

#### Short Title

1. This By-law may be cited as the Garbage Collection By-law No. 120.

#### Operation

2. This By-law shall have effect and operation the day following notice of its making is published in the *Victoria Government Gazette*.

3. This By-law shall apply to and have operation in those parts of the municipal district of the Shire of Waranga specified in the schedule hereto.

#### By-laws Repealed

4. (a) By-law Number 99 of the Shire of Waranga is hereby repealed.

- (b) By-law No. 103 is amended as follows:

- (i) In Clause 1 delete the words "Garbage Collection";

- (ii) Clause 5 is hereby repealed.

- (c) By-law 113 is amended by repealing any reference to By-law No. 99 in the Schedule to Clause 2.

#### Garbage Collection By-law

5. In this By-law unless inconsistent with the context or subject matter—

"Council" means the Council of the Shire of Waranga.

"Flat" means a portion of a building used or intended adapted or designed for use as a dwelling and includes any land surrounding or adjacent thereto within the same tenement.

"Occupier" means the occupier, owner, tenant, the person in charge or having the management or control of the premises.

"Premises" includes messuages, houses, flats, units, buildings, land and hereditaments of every tenure.

"Receptacle" means a mobile cart constructed of high density plastic material having a maximum capacity of 240 litres, and constructed so as to prevent the absorption of any matter that may be deposited therein or the escape by leakage or otherwise of any part of the contents of such receptacle. It shall be provided with a strongly hinged lid of the same material as the body and be fitted with two wheels and two strong handles so as to enable easy manoeuvrability.

"Refuse" means all waste material (except nightsoil, sewage and manure) produced or accumulated in or about any house, building or premises.

"Unit" means a stratum which is shown as a unit on a plan of strata or Cluster Subdivision and includes a unit specified as an accessory unit.

6. The occupier of every premises shall keep and maintain the receptacle supplied by the Council at all times upon the premises into which all refuse shall be deposited with the least possible delay. Such receptacle shall remain the property of the Council and is not transferable.

7. A person shall not use for the collection of refuse as herein required any receptacle save as herein defined and as provided by the Council.

8. The occupier of every house flat unit or other premises shall provide a clearly defined area for the storage of receptacles.

9. The occupier shall cause such receptacles to be kept at all times in good order and condition, clean and disinfected and shall pay all repairs and/or replacement costs in the event of damage or loss due to the act or default of the occupier.

10. A person shall not place refuse in a receptacle in such a manner that will prevent the lid of such receptacle from closing properly.

11. The occupier shall not cause or permit to be placed in a receptacle any live ashes, soil, paints, solvents or inflammable substances or any object which will cause damage to the receptacle or be dangerous.

12. The occupier shall keep the refuse in such receptacle in an inoffensive condition by the introduction of a sufficient quantity of deodorant or disinfectant or such other means.

13. The occupier shall not use or permit to be used the receptacle for any purpose other than for the collection of refuse therein.

14. Every receptacle shall have on the external surface painted or affixed thereto in clearly legible lettering the street number, and also in the case of flats or units the number of each flat or unit.

15. 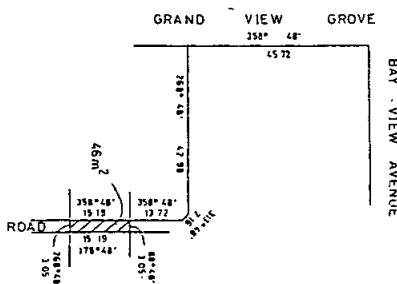
