OVENS RIVER (WANGARATTA) WATER SUPPLY CATCHMENT

Proclamation

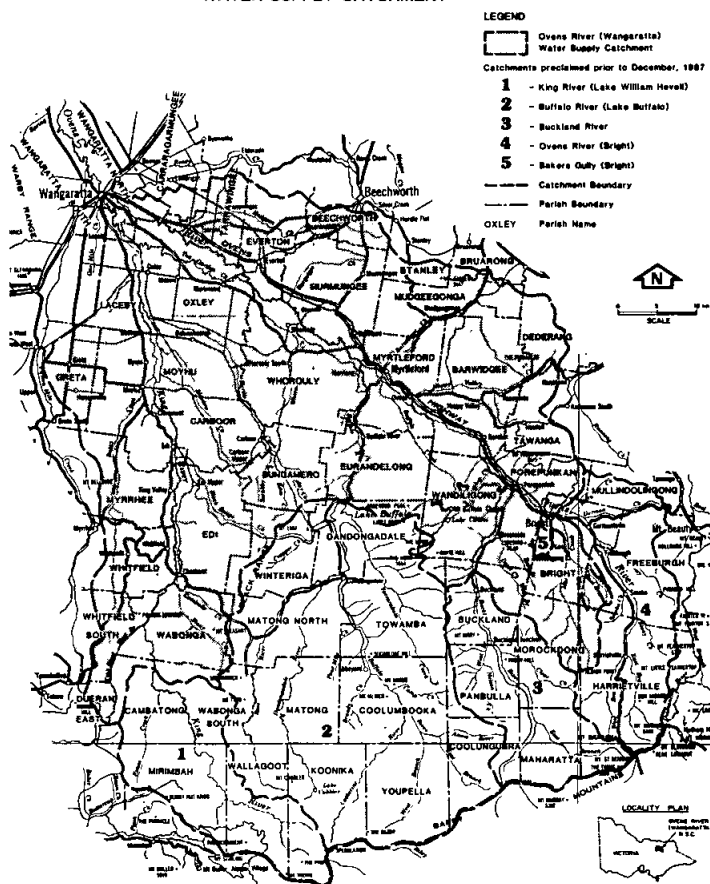
I, J. Davis McCaughey, Governor of Victoria, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, having considered a recommendation of the Land Conservation Council under section 5 (1) (b) of the *Land Conservation Act 1970* (No. 8008) and acting under section 22 (1) of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act 1958* (No. 6372), define the water supply catchment area to be known as the Owens River (Wangaratta) Water Supply Catchment.

The area defined is the balance of the land not previously proclaimed in the catchment to an offtake pump controlled by the Wangaratta Water Board on the Owens River adjacent to Crown allotment 7, section 41 in the Parish of Wangaratta North.

The use of land within this catchment is subject to specification by notice or by determination made by the Director-General, Department of Conservation, Forests and Lands, acting under section 22 (2) and section 23 (1) (a), (b) and (c) of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act 1958*, as amended.

The area described is indicated in Plan No. S-1464, the original of which is lodged at the Kew office of the Department of Conservation, Forests and Lands at 378 Cotham Road.

DIRECTIONS WITH RESPECT TO THE ELECTION OF COUNCILLORS

DIRECTION 1

Counting of Votes

(A) For the purposes of this Direction:

(B) A reference to votes of or obtained or received by a candidate includes votes obtained or received by the candidate on any transfer.

(C) The returning officer upon receipt of the several sealed parcels from any authorised person and with the assistance of any authorised persons and in the presence and subject to the inspection of any 1 scrutineer, if present, appointed by each candidate but of no other person must—

(i) open all the sealed parcels containing used ballot-papers; and

(ii) arrange the ballot-papers together with the allowed postal ballot-papers, if any, by placing in a separate parcel

all those on which a first preference is indicated for the same candidate and preference votes are also duly given for all the remaining candidates, omitting ballot-papers which are rejected; and

(iii) ascertain—

(a) the number of first preference votes given for each candidate; and

(b) the total number of first preference votes.

(D) A quota is to be determined.

(E) Any candidate who has received a number of first preference votes equal to or greater than the quota is to be declared duly elected by the returning officer.

(F) Unless all the vacancies have been filled, the surplus votes of each elected candidate are to be transferred to the continuing candidates as follows:

(i) The number of surplus votes of the elected candidate is to be divided by the number of first preference votes received by the elected candidate and the resulting fraction is the transfer value;

(ii) The total number of ballot-papers of the elected candidate that express the first preference vote for the elected candidate and the next available preference for a particular continuing candidate is to be multiplied by the transfer value;

(iii) The number obtained under paragraph (ii) (disregarding any fraction) is to be added to the number of first preference votes of the continuing candidate and all those ballot-papers are to be transferred to the continuing candidate.

(G) Any continuing candidate who has received a number of votes equal to or greater than the quota on the completion of any transfer under direction (F) is to be declared duly elected by the returning officer.

(H) Unless all the vacancies have been filled, the surplus votes, if any, of any candidate elected under direction (G) or elected subsequently under this direction are to be transferred to the continuing candidates in accordance with direction (F) and any continuing candidate who has received a number of votes equal to or greater than the quota on the completion of the transfer is to be declared duly elected by the returning officer.

- (I) Where a continuing candidate has received a number of votes equal to or greater than the quota on the completion of a transfer of the surplus votes of a particular elected candidate under direction (F) or (H) no votes of any other candidate are to be transferred to the continuing candidate.
- (J) For the purposes of the application of direction (F) in relation to a transfer of the surplus votes of an elected candidate under direction (H) or (M), each ballot-paper of the elected candidate obtained by the elected candidate on a transfer is to be dealt with as if—
- (i) any vote it expressed for the elected candidate were a first preference vote; and
 - (ii) the name of any other candidate previously elected or excluded had not been on the ballot-paper; and
 - (iii) the numbers indicating subsequent preferences had been altered accordingly.
- (K) Where, after the counting of first preference votes or the transfer of any surplus votes of elected candidates, no candidate has, or less than the number of candidates required to be elected have, received a number of votes equal to the quota, the candidate who has the fewest votes is to be excluded and all that candidate's votes are to be transferred to the continuing candidates as follows:
- (i) The total number of ballot-papers of the excluded candidate that express the first preference vote for the excluded candidate and the next available preference for a particular continuing candidate are to be transferred at a transfer value of 1 for each ballot-paper and added to the number of votes of the continuing candidate and all those ballot-papers are to be transferred to the continuing candidate;
 - (ii) The total number, if any, of other votes obtained by the excluded candidate on transfers are to be transferred from the excluded candidate in the order of the transfers in which the excluded candidate obtained them, the votes obtained on the earliest transfer being transferred first, as follows:
 - (a) The total number of ballot-papers transferred to the excluded candidate from a particular candidate and expressing the next available preference for a particular continuing candidate is to be multiplied by the transfer value at which the votes were so transferred to the excluded candidate;
 - (b) The number so obtained (disregarding any fraction) is to be added to the number of votes of the continuing candidate; and
 - (c) All those ballot-papers are to be transferred to the continuing candidate.
- (L) Any continuing candidate who has received a number of votes equal to or greater than the quota on the completion of a transfer of votes of an excluded candidate under direction (K) or (O) is to be declared duly elected by the returning officer.
- (M) Subject to direction (N), unless all the vacancies have been filled the surplus votes, if any, of a candidate elected under direction (L) are to be transferred in accordance with direction (F).
- (N) Where a candidate elected under direction (L) is elected before all the votes of the excluded candidate have been transferred, the surplus votes, if any, of the elected candidate are not to be transferred until the remaining votes of the excluded candidate have been transferred in accordance with direction (K) to continuing candidates.
- (O) Subject to direction (Q), where after the transfer of all the votes of an excluded candidate no continuing candidate has received a number of votes greater than the quota—
- (i) the continuing candidate who has the fewest votes must be excluded; and
 - (ii) that candidate's votes must be transferred in accordance with direction (K).
- (P) Where a candidate is elected as a result of a transfer of—
- (i) the first preference votes of an excluded candidate; or
 - (ii) all the votes of an excluded candidate that were transferred to the excluded candidate from a particular candidate—

no other votes of the excluded candidate are to be transferred to the candidate so elected.

- (Q) In respect of the last vacancy for which 2 continuing candidates remain, the continuing candidate who has the larger number of votes is to be elected notwithstanding that that number is below the quota and if those candidates have an equal number of votes the result is to be determined by lot by the returning officer.
- (R) Notwithstanding any other provision of this direction, where the number of continuing candidates is equal to the number of remaining unfilled vacancies those candidates are to be declared duly elected by the returning officer.
- (S) Subject to directions (T) and (V), where after any count or transfer, 2 or more candidates have surplus votes the order of any transfers of the surplus votes of those candidates is to be in accordance with the relative size of the surpluses, the largest surplus being transferred first.
- (T) Subject to direction (V), where after any count or transfer, 2 or more candidates have equal surpluses, the order of any transfers of the surplus votes of those candidates is to be in accordance with the relative numbers of votes of those candidates at the last count or transfer at which each of those candidates had a different number of votes, the surplus of the candidate with the largest number of votes at that count or transfer being transferred first.
- (U) For the purposes of direction (T), if there has been no count or transfer the returning officer must determine the order in which the surpluses are to be dealt with.
- (V) If after any count or transfer, a candidate obtains surplus votes, those surplus votes are not to be transferred before the transfer of any surplus votes obtained by any other candidate on an earlier count or transfer.
- (W) Where the candidate who has the fewest votes is required to be excluded and 2 or more candidates each have the fewest votes, whichever of those candidates had the fewest votes at the last count or transfer at which each of those candidates had a difference number of votes is to be excluded.
- (X) For the purposes of direction (W), if there has been no count or transfer the returning officer must determine which candidate is to be excluded.

- (Y) Where a candidate is elected by reason that—
 - (i) the number of first preference votes received by the candidate; or
 - (ii) the aggregate of first preference votes received by the candidate and all other votes obtained by the candidate on transfers—
 is equal to the quota, all the ballot-papers expressing those votes are to be set aside as finally dealt with.
- (Z) A ballot-paper must be set aside as exhausted where on a transfer it is found that the ballot-paper expresses no preference for any continuing candidate.
- (ZA) For the purposes of this direction each of the following constitutes a separate transfer:
 - (i) A transfer under direction (F), (H) or (M) of all the surplus votes of an elected candidate;
 - (ii) A transfer in accordance with direction (K) (i) of all first preference votes of an excluded candidate;
 - (iii) A transfer in accordance with direction (K) (ii) of all the votes of an excluded candidate that were transferred to that candidate from a particular candidate.

DIRECTION 2

The counting of votes may be assisted by the use of electronic equipment and where electronic equipment is used, anything in the *Local Government Act 1958* requiring manual counting inconsistent with the use of such equipment need not be followed.

DIRECTION 3

- (A) Any ballot-paper which expresses preferences for at least three candidates or expresses preferences for more than three candidates is a valid ballot-paper and is to be included in the counting of votes to the extent possible having regard to the preferences expressed.
- (B) Where there is any duplication or omission in the sequence of preferences expressed in a valid ballot-paper under direction A that ballot-paper is to be included in the counting of votes to the extent possible up to the duplication or omission in the sequence of preferences expressed.

 - (i) a tender and application in a form provided by the Road Traffic Authority must be duly completed by the applicant, sealed in an envelope and submitted to the Authority's Vehicle Licensing Branch, 2nd Floor, Cnr Lygon and Princes Streets, Carlton not later than 4.00 p.m. on 13 May 1988;
 - (ii) the tender and application must contain the following particulars—
 - the taxi-cab zone in which the taxi-cab will operate;
 - name, address and date of birth of the applicant;
 - the amount tendered as the licence fee;
 - description of the vehicle;
 - the address from which the vehicle is to operate;
 - a declaration of interest in any current taxi-cab or hire car licence;
 - driver's certificate details including date of issue, classification and expiry date; and

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- a declaration of taxi-cab driving experience;
- (iii) the Authority shall issue the licences to the person(s) who meets the eligibility criteria, and submits highest tender;
- (e) declares that all applications for taxi-cab licences to operate in the Koo-Wee-Rup Taxi-cab Zone lodged prior to 20 April 1988 are to lapse;
- (f) the Koo-Wee-Rup Taxi-cab Zone is defined as a 7 kilometre radius of the post offices at Tooradin, Koo-Wee-Rup and Lang Lang and the area bounded by parallel lines drawn between the outer-circumference of the three radii.

1. This By-Law shall be known as the Control of Fires By-Law.

2. In this By-Law unless inconsistent with the context or subject matter:

G 14 20 April 1988 983

"Barbeque" includes any device or contraption used or adapted for use for cooking in the open air.

"Building" includes a dwelling and any buildings whether temporary or permanent and any part thereof and includes out buildings.

"Rural property" shall mean land of not less than two hectares with no more than one dwelling for each two hectares of total area.

3. No person shall light or being the owner or occupier of property shall cause or permit any person to light any fire or suffer any fire to remain alight in the open air on such property save and except:

- (a) With the prior consent in writing:
 - (i) of an authorised Officer of the Council and in accordance with any conditions set out in such consent; or
 - (ii) pursuant to Council's By-Law No. 75.
- (b) Pursuant to the valid issue of a Permit to Burn under the *Country Fire Authority Act 1958*,
- (c) In a barbeque constructed of brick, masonry, metal or a combination of these materials or other material approved by the Council and used for the purpose of cooking meat or other edible matter only; or
- (d) In an incinerator which is:
 - (i) constructed of brick, masonry, steel or a combination of these materials or other materials approved by the Council; and
 - (ii) fitted with an effective lid or door, flue pipe and a spark arrestor and be so constructed as to prevent the emission of sparks or the spread of fire therefrom; and
 - (iii) situated at least 3 metres from the nearest point of any boundary of the land; and
 - (iv) situated at least 7.5 metres from the nearest point of any building on the same land; and
 - (v) situated at least 12 metres from the nearest point of any building on adjoining land; and
 - (vi) surrounded for a horizontal distance of 3 metres by open ground which is free from combustible material; and
 - (vii) clear of overhanging foliage for a vertical distance of 3 metres;

provided that such specified distances may in any particular case be modified, varied or waived by the Council or an authorised Officer.

4. No person shall light or being the owner or occupier of any property shall cause or permit any person to light a fire in an incinerator or in the open air (except in a barbeque):

- (a) On any day being a Saturday, Sunday, Monday or declared public holiday; or
- (b) On a smog alert day; or
- (c) On more than one day in a calendar week; or
- (d) On more than two hours per day whether continuous or intermittent use.

provided that such fire is not lit before 10 o'clock in the morning and is completely extinguished prior to 4.00 o'clock in the afternoon.

5. Clauses 3 and 4 shall not apply to rural property.

6. Any fire lit by any person whether or not consent has been obtained pursuant to this By-Law, shall be extinguished upon the order of an authorised Officer and any person who wilfully refused or neglects to extinguish such fire upon such order shall be guilty of an offence against this By-Law.

7. No person shall at any time burn or being the owner or occupier of property cause or permit to be burned:

- (a) Any rubber or plastic substance; or
- (b) Any oil or substance or material containing oil; or
- (c) Any paints or any receptacles which contain or contained paints; or
- (d) Any chemicals; or
- (e) Any wet material; or
- (f) Any food wastes; or
- (g) Any substance in such a manner to such an extent as shall cause quantities of smoke, fumes, odours or ash to be emitted from the said premises so as to cause a nuisance to any person upon any land or upon any public place.

8. Any person guilty of a wilful act or default contrary to the provisions of this By-Law shall be liable to a penalty of not less than one penalty unit nor more than ten penalty units and any person guilty of a continuing offence against this By-Law after conviction or Order by any Court shall be liable to a penalty of no more than one penalty unit for each day on which an offence against this By-Law is continued.
