PUBLIC CEMETERY**

**RULES AND REGULATIONS—MILDURA  
PUBLIC CEMETERY**

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the *Cemeteries Act* the Trustees of Mildura Cemetery hereby make the following Regulations which shall come into operation upon publication in the *Government Gazette*:

*Conditions regarding memorial works:*

- (a) A permit is to be submitted for approval of the Trust.

- (e) No works or after hours memorial work will be allowed without good reason and without the prior consent of the Sexton. If a grave site location is required outside normal working hours then an extra fee of \$25.00 is payable.
