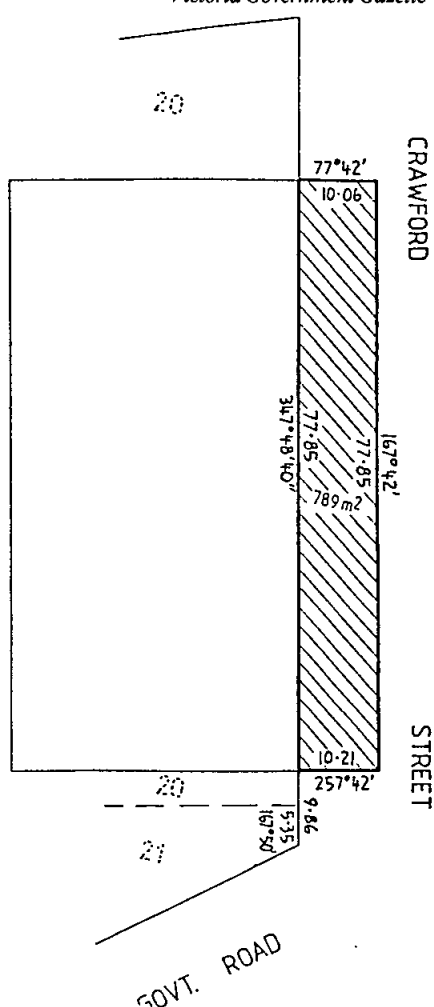

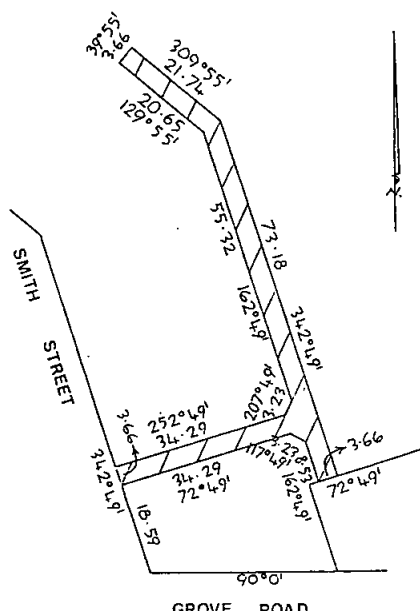

Victorian Biscuit Award

4 PER CENT SECOND TIER—NOTICE OF PROPOSED AWARD VARIATION

Following the State Wage Case Decision of March 1988 notice is hereby given that the Pastrycooks, Bakers, Biscuitmakers and Allied Trades Union (P.B.B. & A.T.U.) has applied for the Decision of Deputy President Keogh of the Australian Conciliation and Arbitration Commission operative from 15 December 1987 (Print H.0121) regarding the Federal Metal Industry Award 1984 Part 2 Second Tier wage increase of 4 per cent to flow to the Victorian Biscuit Award.

The Decision of Deputy President Keogh provides for employers and their employees to negotiate productivity and efficiency agreements to allow for that wage increase.

P.B.B. & A.T.U. has requested negotiations with employers subject to the jurisdiction of the Biscuit Conciliation and Arbitration Board on the claim.

The Biscuit Conciliation and Arbitration Board has directed employers, subject to the jurisdiction of the Board to immediately enter into negotiations with their employees.

Any employer who has not finalised a plant or enterprise agreement in accordance with the State Wage Case April 1987 by 30 September 1988 is at liberty to apply for exemption from the proposed Second Tier award. Objections to be lodged with the Deputy Registrar no later than close of business on 29 September 1988.

BULLOCK CREEK IMPROVEMENT TRUST

By-Law No. 16

The Bullock Creek Improvement Trust, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the *River Improvement Act* 1958, doth make the By-Law following:

1. The following rate, to be called the Bullock Creek District River Improvement Rate, is hereby made and shall be levied upon the occupiers or owners of all properties within the Bullock Creek Improvement Trust District which are rateable to any Municipality, a rate of 0.8 cents in the dollar on the nett annual Municipal value of all those properties within the first division of the district.

Provided that the sum of two dollars shall be the minimum amount payable in respect of any property liable to be rated in the said division.

2. Such rates are made and shall be levied for the year beginning with 1 January 1988, and ending with 31 December 1988 and shall be payable on 16 December 1987, at the Office of the Bullock Creek Improvement Trust, Shire Office, Boort.

3. Such person or persons as the Bullock Creek Improvement Trust may from time to time appoint for that purpose shall be and is or are authorised to demand, receive, collect and recover the said rate.

Commercial Passenger Vehicle and Tow Truck Applications

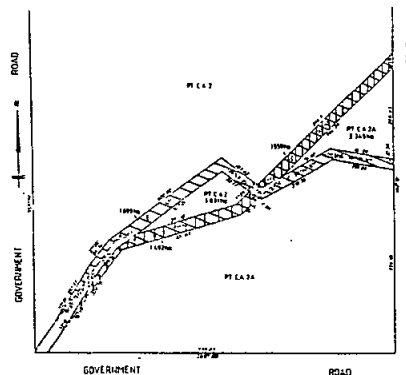

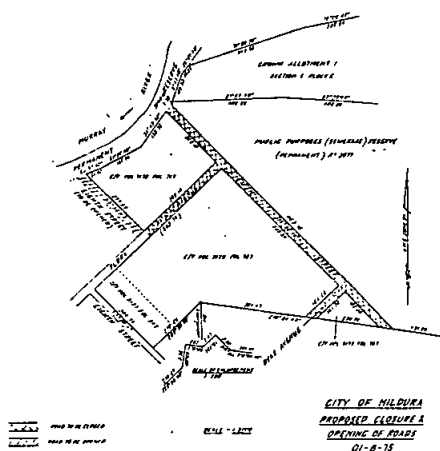

ORDER OF EXEMPTION No. 25

The Deputy Governor in Council under section 9 of the *Boilers and Pressure Vessels Act 1970* makes the following order:

1. This Order relates to fired steam boilers of the Fire Tube or Water Tube types with maximum power output ratings of up to and including 20MW.
2. Any boiler of the class referred to in clause 1 is exempted from Division 2 of Part II of the *Boilers and Pressure Vessels Act 1970* provided that:
 - (a) the design, construction, installation, use and maintenance of the boiler are in accordance with the Australian Standard No. 2593 for Unattended Boilers published by the Australian Standards Association on 7 February 1983 and the amendments to the Standard published on 5 January 1987 and the Chief Inspector has furnished a certificate to that effect; and
 - (b) the owner of the boiler ensures that a person holding a Certificate of Competency under Division 2 of Part II of the *Boilers and Pressure Vessels Act 1970* performs:
 - (i) a manual start-up of the boiler at least once each day; and
 - (ii) a visual check of all boiler controls, safety devices and the general conditions of the boiler and boiler house at the commencement of each shift and at least once every 4 hours of shift duration; and
 - (c) the owner of the boiler keeps daily records on:
 - (i) the names of the person(s) carrying out the manual start-ups and visual checks referred to in sub-clause 2 (b);
 - (ii) the times when those manual start-ups and visual checks were carried out;
 - (iii) a report on each manual start-up and visual check including particulars of any malfunction noted; and
 - (d) the owner of the boiler retains the records referred to in sub-clause 2 (c) for the period of eighteen months and makes them available to an Inspector upon demand;
 - (e) when during the course of a manual start-up, or visual check referred to in 2 (b), a malfunction of the automatic control system is detected, the owner must ensure

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that the further operation of the boiler is supervised by a person holding a certificate of competency under Division 2 of part II of the *Boilers and Pressure Vessels Act 1970*. The supervision must be continued until the malfunction is rectified.
