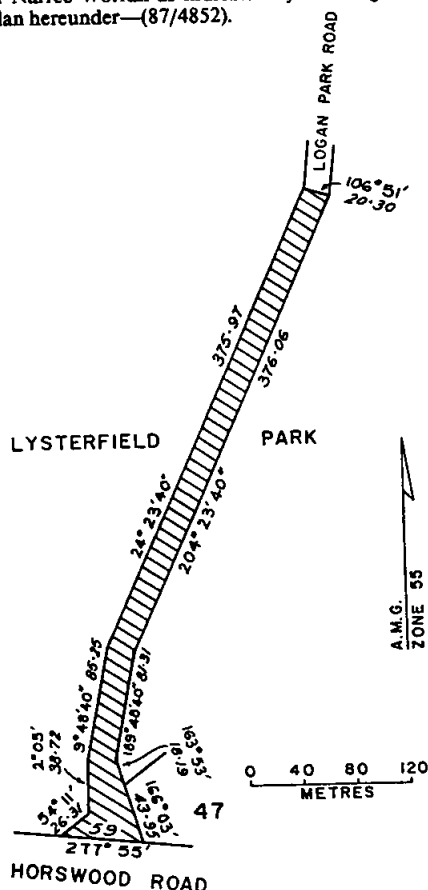

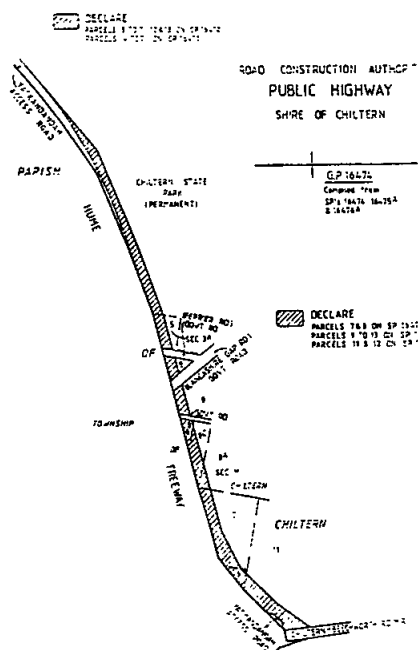
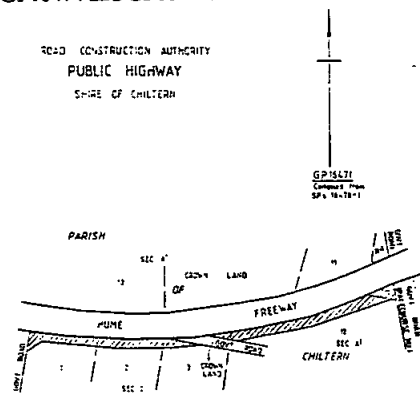

NOTICE DECLARING NEW ROADS TO BE FIT TO BE USED AS PUBLIC HIGHWAYS

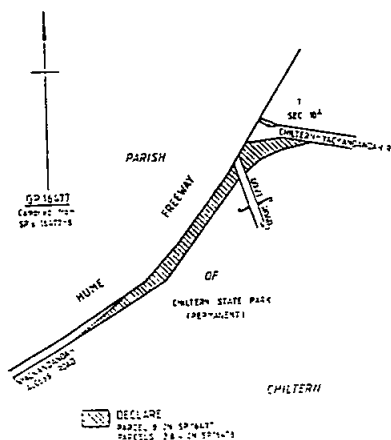
The Road Construction Authority is of the opinion that the new roads as set out below are fit to be used as public highways—

MITCHELL RIVER NATIONAL PARK— HUNTING OF DEER BY STALKING

I, Donald Sydney Saunders, Director of National Parks and Wildlife, under section 37 (3) of the *National Parks Act 1975* authorise any person holding a current shooting licence with hunting endorsement to carry and use a firearm in the part of Mitchell River National Park east of the Mitchell River during the period 15 February to 15 December inclusive each year for the purpose of hunting deer by stalking.
