## FLINDERS PLANNING SCHEME

## Amendment L4

The Minister for Planning and Environment has approved Amendment L4 to the Flinders Planning Scheme.

The amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the *Government Gazette*.

The amendment amends the car parking provisions of the Flinders Planning Scheme as they affect "restaurant" (in the Commercial Zone), "showroom", "shop" and "office".

#### SOLICITORS' (PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT AND PRACTICE) (AMENDMENT No. 2) RULES 1988

In the pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Legal Profession Practice Act* 1958 and all other powers thereunto enabling the Council of the Law Institute hereby makes the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the Solicitors' (Professional Conduct and Practice) (Amendment No. 2) Rules 1988 and shall come into operation on the date of their publication in the *Victoria Government Gazette*.

2. The Solicitors' (Professional Conduct and Practice) Rules 1984 are in these Rules referred to as the Principal Rules.

3. Rule 4 of the Principal Rules is amended as follows:

After sub-Rule 4 (4) insert the following:

"(5) A solicitor shall not, without the consent of the Council, carry on practice as a solicitor under a business name which, or in the case of an incorporated practitioner, the name of which comprises or includes—

(a) a name other than—

(i) the solicitor's name or in the case of an incorporated practitioner, the name of any director, shareholder or participating employee of the incorporated practitioner;

(ii) the name of any other person or incorporated practitioner carrying on that practice;

(iii) the name of any person who previously carried on that practice or was a director shareholder or participating employee of the incorporated practitioner;

(iv) the name of a practice which previously carried on that practice;

(v) the name (or part of the name) of a practice with which that practice merged;

(vi) a name which is a conjunction of any of the names referred to in paragraphs (i)-(v)" or

(vii) the plural or possessive form of any of the names referred to in paragraphs (i)-(vi)".

4. After Rule 10 of the Principal Rules insert—  
"11. Notwithstanding the provisions of Rule 10—

(1) a solicitor acting for a vendor, a purchaser, a lessor or a lessee in the offering for sale or lease, or in negotiating for the sale, purchase or lease of or in selling, purchasing or leasing of land or a



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business, without the involvement of a real estate or business agent acting on behalf of the solicitor's client and where the solicitor is performing a function commonly performed by a real estate or business agent, shall not act—

- (a) for the purchaser or any lender of money to the purchaser where the loan has any connection with the particular transaction, if the solicitor acts for the vendor;
- (b) for the vendor or any lender of money to the vendor where the loan has any connection with the particular transaction, if the solicitor acts for the purchaser;
- (c) for the lessee or any lender of money to the lessee where the loan has any connection with the particular transaction, if the solicitor acts for the lessor; or
- (d) for the lessor or any lender of money to the lessor where the loan has any connection with the particular transaction, if the solicitor acts for the lessee.

(2) For the purpose of this Rule—

Reference to a solicitor acting or not acting includes the partner, principal or employee of the solicitor.

'land' has the same meaning as in section 2 (1) of the *Sale of Land Act 1962*.

'solicitor' has the same meaning as in section 51 of the *Legal Profession Practice Act 1958*."

3. Rule 3 of the Principal Rules is amended as follows:

(1) In sub-rule 3 (d) after "part of those receipts" insert—

"or with a company or companies, the shares of which are held by the solicitor or the spouse, child or grandchild of the solicitor or any one or more of them, but not any other person unless that other person holds the shares beneficially only for the solicitor or the spouse, child or grandchild of the solicitor or any one or more of them".

In accordance with the provisions of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1962*, notice is given of the proposal to make the abovementioned Regulations.

A Regulatory Impact Statement has been prepared in respect of each of the proposed Regulations.

The Regulations will enable the *Marine Act 1988* to be brought into force and will, together with the Act, provide for prescription of requirements in respect of commercial and recreational vessels and their operation on Victorian waters.

Matters dealt with in the Regulations include the following:

- registration of vessels
- survey and crewing of vessels
- pilots, pilot exemption and local knowledge
- construction of and equipment for commercial and recreational vessels including hire and drive vessels

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prohibition of the operation of certain vessels  
provisions relating to blood and breath tests  
marine infringements  
provisions relating to radar speed measuring  
devices  
election of a member of the Marine Board  
by pilots  
adoption of section 15 of the Uniform  
Shipping Laws Code as to emergency  
procedures and safety of navigation for  
commercial vessels  
adoption of the international regulations for  
preventing collisions at sea  
prescription of fees relating to certificates of  
service, examinations and certificates of  
competency, pilot licences, pilot exemption  
certificates, inspection of hire and drive  
vessels, surveys, examination of plans,  
adjustment of compasses, boating facilities  
and safety education, special identification  
marks and plates, transfers of vessels and  
assessors.

Many of the Regulations re-state existing  
requirements, however some important changes  
are proposed the more important of which are as  
follows:

expanded use of infringement notices (or 'on  
the spot' fines) and increased penalties  
requirements concerning retro-reflective tape  
on personal flotation devices  
a requirement that children under the age of  
10 years wear a lifejacket or similar device  
in certain circumstances when on board a  
vessel  
the giving of power to the Marine Board or  
the police to direct that an unsafe vessel shall  
not be operated on State waters.

The broad objective to be achieved by the  
Regulations is to provide for the efficient and  
safe operation of commercial and recreational  
vessels on State waters.

The Regulatory Impact Statements conclude  
that the proposed Regulations are appropriate,  
that the benefits outweigh the costs and that other  
possible alternatives would be less effective.

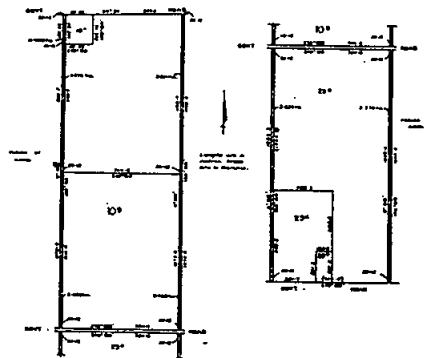

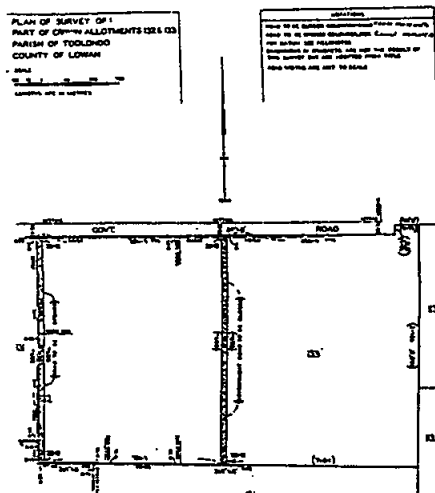

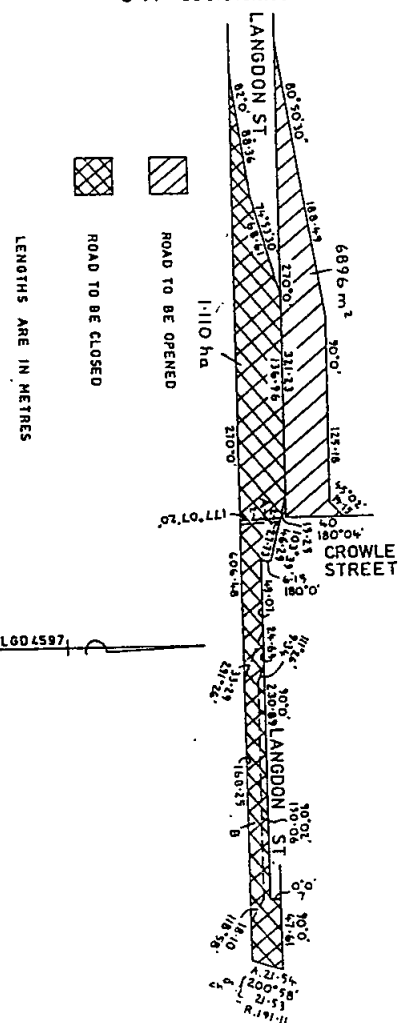

General mass permit for vehicles making local deliveries of bulk grain etc, during the 1988-89 harvest.

Regulation 724 of the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 1988 empowers the Road Traffic Authority, by notice in the *Government Gazette*, to allow vehicles which exceed mass or dimension limits prescribed in the regulations to be used on highways.

### *Principal Regulations*

2. In these Regulations the \*Victoria Racing Club (Flemington Racecourse) Rules and Regulations 1978 are called the Principal Regulations.

*Objective*

3. The objective of these Regulations is to set apart additional areas of Flemington Racecourse for use by bookmakers operating during the Spring Racing Carnival.

*Enabling Provision*

4. These Regulations are made under section 5 of the *Racing Act* 1958.

*Amendment of Definition*

5. In Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations for the definition of "Plan" substitute " "Plan" means the plan in Schedule Two or, in the case of Regulation 3 (j) and (k), Schedule Three.'.

*Amendment of Regulation 3*

6. After paragraph (g) of Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations insert—

- (h) That part of the racecourse delineated and hatched as per style "G" on the plan and marked the "Elms Area".
- (i) That part of the racecourse delineated and hatched as per style "H" on the plan and marked the "Ascot Enclosure".
- (j) Those parts of the Members' Car Park delineated and hatched as per style "I" on the plan and marked as "Members' Car Park A" and "Members' Car Park B".
- (k) That part of the Public Car Park delineated and hatched on the plan as per style "J" on the plan and marked the "Willows".

*Amendment of Regulation 8*

7. After paragraph (g) of Regulation 8 (1) of the Principal Regulations insert—

- (h) In those parts of the racecourse delineated and hatched as per styles "G", "H", "I" and "J" on the plan and marked respectively as the "Elms Area", "Ascot Enclosure", "Members' Car Park A", "Members' Car Park B" and "Willows"—\$93 per day on each of the four days of the Spring Racing Carnival only.

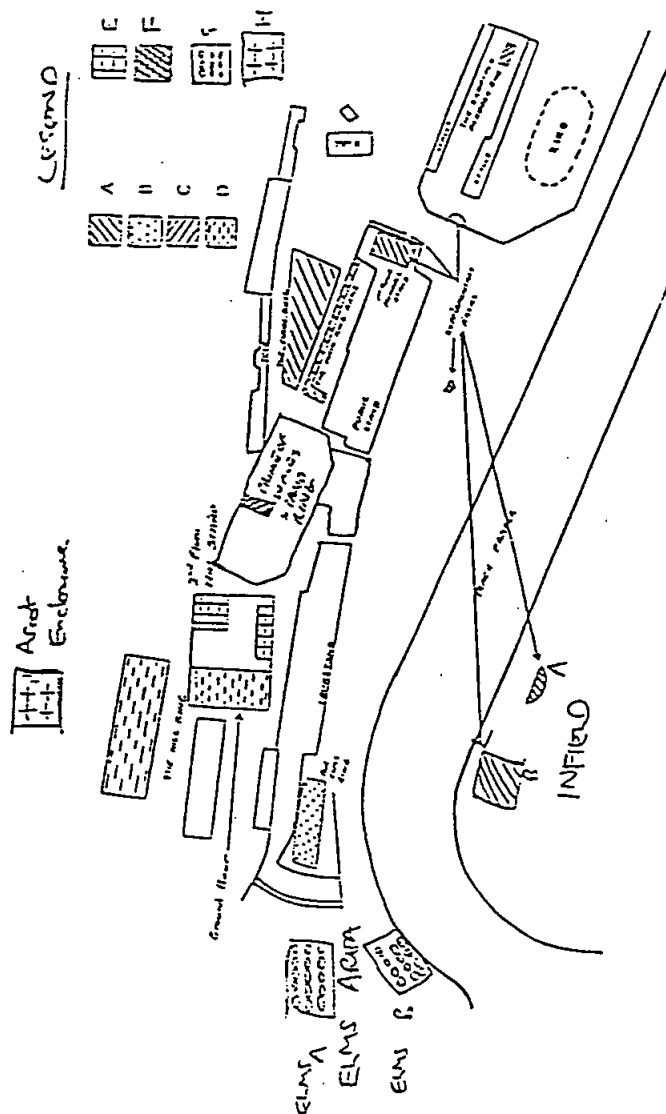
