Notice of Approval of Amendment  
Amendment RL96

The Minister for Planning and Environment has approved Amendment RL96 to the Regional Section of all metropolitan planning schemes and to the Local Section of the Port Melbourne Planning Scheme.

The amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the *Government Gazette*.

The amendment reintroduces the Comprehensive Development Zone No. 9 (Bayside Project Area). This zone provides for the redevelopment of the Bayside Project Area in Port Melbourne for a variety of uses including offices, shops, residential use and a marina.

The amendment incorporates a number of changes to the original zone provisions which will reduce the overall scale of the proposed development.

A copy of the amendment can be inspected, free of charge, during office hours at the Ministry for Planning and Environment, Ground Floor, The Oldfleet Buildings, 477 Collins Street, Melbourne, and the offices of the City of Port Melbourne, Town Hall, Bay Street, Port Melbourne.

A copy of the Regional Section of the amendment can be inspected at the offices of all municipalities in the metropolitan area.
