  - (ii) the basis regarded by the Committee as the most appropriate basis for reporting debt; and
  - (iii) date for each authority adjusted to the basis recommended under paragraph (ii) as at 30 June 1982, 1988 and 1992;
- (d) for each authority any changes in accounting practices since 1981 which would affect the reported level of debt and the effect on reported debt each year since the change was implemented; the appropriate debt limit for each authority in respect of each financial year up to and including 1991-2;
- (f) expected aggregate interest costs for each authority (including a separate delineation of capitalised interest) to be payable each financial year from 1988-89 up to and including 1991-2;
- (g) changes in holdings of financial assets each year since 1980/1 and expected changes each financial year up and including 1991-2;
- (h) any other information or matter relevant to any of the foregoing; to debt limits or the mechanism for setting debt limits or which should be reported to Parliament for the setting of debt limits and the process for supply of that information.
