EMERALD DISTRICT WATER BOARD By-Law No. 26

Minor Trade Waste Agreements

- 1. The Emerald District Water Board pursuant to and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on it by the Sewerage Districts Act 1958 and of any other power or authority in any wise enabling it in that behalf, doth hereby make and prescribe the following By-Law that is to say:
 - 2. Conditions of Discharge
 - (i) No person shall discharge any trade or manufacturing liquid, refuse or waste (excluding ordinary domestic sewage) into any sewer, unless and until the following conditions are complied with:
 - (a) Application for permission to discharge any such trade wastes shall be made, in writing, and shall include such details concerning the nature of the wastes including biological and chemical composition and the quantity and rates of discharge of the proposed effluent as considered necessary by the Proper Officer of the Water Board.
 - (b) The permission of the Water Board given by a grant of licence in writing, shall be obtained and an agreement containing a covenant to comply with the By-Laws and the Regulations for a period and with any further stipulations required by the Water Board shall be executed. The volume of liquid refuse and waste discharged shall, if ordered, be measured and determined by meter or by some other approved means of measurement as determined by the Water Board from time to time. The Water Board may at any time install or require to be installed such equipment as in the opinion of the Authorised Officer is considered to be necessary to measure the level of any component or characteristic of a waste and the occupier shall pay all the costs of monitoring and installation of such equipment and where such equipment is required to be installed on a permanent basis the occupier shall pay all the costs and expenses of such equipment and all the installation costs and the equipment shall become the property of the occupier.

The maximum daily aggregate quantity of effluent which may pass from any trade premises into a sewer,

the maximum permissible rate of such discharge the size and capacity of the drain or pipe for conveying such effluent from the trade premises to the sewer, and the hours during which such flow will be permitted shall be determined by the Water Board.

- (c) All such liquid refuse or waste shall be passed through such settling, screening, and/or neutralising chambers and/or otherwise be treated as ordered or approved by the Water Board to ensure that the resulting effluents shall comply with the conditions of the agreement. These appliances shall include a sampling pit on the premises to enable the Water Board to collect Treatment Apparatus Discharge samples for checking compliance with the Agreement.
- (d) Every metering, settling, screening, neutralising, or other chamber, appliance or apparatus for the treatment of trade wastes in accordance with the By-Laws and the Regulations shall be cleansed, operated and maintained by the occupier at his own expense and at such intervals as to ensure that all waste discharged from such chamber, appliance, or apparatus complies at all times with the requirements of the Agreement to discharge the waste. In no case shall such chamber, appliance, or apparatus be altered vithout the approval in writing of the Water Board first being obtained.
- (e) The Water Board reserves the right to enter into a separate Agreement with any person or Company for the discharge of any waste which differs from the tolerances determined in this By-Law. (This By-Law is intended for typical minor Trade Waste Agreements).
- 3. No person shall cause or permit to flow or pass or be carried without the specific written approval of the Water Board, from any manufacturing or business or other premises of any such person into any sewer of the Water Board or any drain or pipe communicating therewith, any wastes (excluding ordinary domestic sewerage), liquids or refuse, and in particular—
 - (1) The pH of which is less than 6 or greater than 8.5

- (2) Containing more than 1 milligram per litre of the following gases: Hydrogen sulphide, sulphur dioxide, nitrous oxide or any of the halogens.
- (3) Containing any explosive substance.
- (4) Containing any flammable substance with a flash point lower than 86° Celsius.
- (5) Having a temperature higher than 38° Celsius.
- (6) Containing grease or oil or other substance that will solidify or become viscous at temperatures between 0* Celsius and 60* Celsius.
- (7) Containing substances in suspension exceeding a daily average of 350 milligrams per litre.
- (8) Containing material with a Biochemical Oxygen demand exceeding a daily average of 350 milligrams per litre.
- (9) Containing total solids in solution and suspension in excess of 2000 milligrams per litre or exceeding a daily average of 1000 milligrams per litre.
- (10) Containing gases or vapours either free or occluded in concentrations which are toxic or dangerous to humans or animals.
- (11) Containing more than 10 milligrams per litre of any antiseptic substance.
- (12) Containing phenols in excess of 0-005 milligrams per litre.
- (13) Containing any toxic or irritating substance which will create conditions hazardous to public health and safety.
- (14) Containing in excess of 100 milligrams per litre or exceeding a daily average of 25 milligrams per litre of any grease or oil or any oily substances.
- (15) Containing cyanogen compounds capable of liberating hydrocyanic acid on acidification.
- (16) Containing carbide.
- (17) Containing tar or tar oil.
- (18) Containing sulphides, hydrosulphides and/or polysulphides.
- (19) Containing carbon bisulphide.
- (20) Containing calcium.
- (21) Containing any radio-active constituents.
- (22) Containing mercury, copper, chromium or other metals with antiseptic action.
- (23) Containing sulphates in excess of 1000 milligrams per litre.
- (24) Containing colour greater than 50 milligrams per litre.
- (25) Total alkalinity exceeding 100 milligrams per litre as calcium carbonate.

- 4. Without limiting the terms and conditions of Section 2 Sub-section (i) hereof, the Proper Officer of the Water Board shall have the right and power to enter from time to time upon and inspect any premises within its Sewerage District for the discharge of liquids wastes and refuse (if any) and to inspect any meters or any other method of measurement approved by the Water Board in order that the officers may measure and compute the actual or the estimated volume of liquids wastes and refuse discharged in any period, the chemical composition of such liquids wastes and refuse and ensure that the By-Laws and Regulations of the Water Board are being complied with in this respect and that any special conditions imposed by the Water Board before the written approval (if any) was granted are being complied with.
- 5. The Water Board shall have the power to grant or renew a licence upon payment of an annual licence charge.

The value of this licence charge shall be set annually by resolution of the Water Board.

6. Water Board's Seal

A resolution for passing this By-Law was agreed to and passed by the Emerald District Water Board at a meeting thereof convened for that purpose on 16 December 1987, and confirmed at a subsequent meeting of Emerald District Water Board on 17 February 1988.

A By-Law of the Shire of Maffra made under the provisions of the Local Government Act 1958 and all other powers thereunto enabling for the

purposes of prohibiting or regulating the placing of caravans on private property and the use of caravans for camping on roads.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by the Local Government Act 1958 and all other powers thereunto enabling the President, Councillors and Ratepayers of the Shire of Maffra order as follows:

- 1. This By-Law shall apply to and have operation throughout the Municipal District of the Shire of Maffra except as hereinafter provided.
- 2. By-Law No. 65 of the Shire of Maffra is hereby repealed.
- 3. In this By-Law unless inconsistent with the context or subject-matter—

"Caravan" includes any car or other vehicle or structure having the general characteristics or a caravan notwithstanding that any of its wheels or axles have been removed or that it is resting directly on the ground or on blocks or that it has been modified or altered in any way and also includes any structures or tents being used in addition to or in conjunction with a caravan.

"the Council" shall mean the Council of the Shire of Maffra.

"the Proprietor" shall include the owner, tenant, occupier or any person or persons having control or management of any private land.

"placing" shall include moving into position, relocating a caravan upon the same property or returning any caravan to a property after a temporary absence.

"camping" shall include the occupation of a caravan for the purpose of eating or sleeping.

- 4. No person shall place on any land or permit or suffer to be placed on any land of which he is the proprietor any caravan unless he has obtained the prior permission in writing of the Council to such placing.
- 5. No person shall permit or suffer to remain on the land of which he is the Proprietor of a caravan which has been placed upon such land without the written consent of the Council.
- 6. No person shall use a caravan for the purpose of camping on any part of a road for any continuous period of more than twenty-four hours without the prior permission in writing of the Council to such use.
 - 7. This By-Law shall not apply to:
 - (a) any caravan placed on private property for the exclusive purpose of being stored, displayed or hired, or to
 - (b) any caravan placed on private property, on which there is a dwelling already situated, for the exclusive use of the

Victoria Government Gazette proprietor of such dwelling, or his family,

- for accommodation purposes, or to

 (c) any caravan placed on private property to
 be used as a temporary dwelling as defined
 under the Shire of Maffra By-Law No. 79.
- (d) any caravan placed on private property whereby that private property is registered with the Shire of Maffra as a Camping Area as defined under the Health Act 1988.
- 3. (a) Every person applying to the Council for consent or a permit under this By-Law shall make application in writing and supply all reasonable information required by the Council including the reasons for seeking such consent, the number, age and sex of the persons proposing to occupy the caravan, the size and location of the caravan and the sanitation facilities to be provided in respect thereof
- (b) The Council may in its absolute discretion grant or refuse its consent to any such application and the Council may grant such application subject to such terms and conditions as it considers desirable.
- (c) Any written consent of the Council which is subject to any terms or conditions for the placing of any caravan shall not constitute a consent in writing for the purposes of this By-Law unless the applicant complies with such terms and conditions.
- (d) Any written consent granted by the Council to the Proprietor of any land to use such land as a site for the placing of a caravan or use of caravans for the caravan camping shall be restricted to all areas within the following zones of the Maffra Planning Scheme.

Chapter 3-Lake Glenmaggie

- -Rural Zone
- -Landscape Interest Zone

Chapter 4-Balance of Shire

- -Rural A Zone
- -Rural B Zone
- -Rural C Zone
- -Rural D Zone
- 10. The Council may at its discretion revoke any permit granted pursuant to subclause (b) of clause 8 hereof if it resolves that the person to whom the said permit has been granted has not fully complied with the conditions of issue of the said permit or any provisions of the Local Government Act 1958 or any other Act or By-Law or regulations made thereunder.
- 11. Every person or persons who contravene or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this By-Law shall be guilty of an offence and shall







Introduction

This is an explanatory report pursuant to the requirements of Section 12 of the Planning and Environment Act in respect of a proposed amendment to the Rodney Planning Scheme.

Context of the Proposed Amendment

The proposed amendment arises in the context of a proposal put forward by the landowner wishing to subdivide the subject land into 29 rural-residential lots.

Subject Land and the Proposal

The subject land is currently being used for agricultural purposes (i.e. dairying). The land is adjoined by a rural-residential estate to the east, which is almost entirely developed for rural-residential purposes. Directly to the north of the land is the Tatura Racecourse. To the west of the land on the western side of the Tatura-Murchison Road, land is used for agricultural purposes (i.e. dairying) and land directly adjoining the subject land to the south is land also being used for agricultural purposes.



Subject Land and the Proposal

The subject land is 16ha in area and is located on the eastern fringe of the Town of Tatura. The subject land is currently vacant and is being used

for agricultural purposes. A rezoning of the land represents an extension of existing ruralresidential areas of the Tatura Township.

Council and the Future Use and Development of the Land

Council has undertaken a number of investigations in relation to the rezoning of the land. The rezoning of the land from Rural 'B' to Rural 'C' will provide for additional ruralresidential land to meet demand for this type of development at the eastern boundary of the Town of Tatura.

The minimum subdivision size under the Rural 'C' zoning is 0-6ha. A rezoning of the land to Rural 'C' would allow for a maximum of 26 lots to be created.

The land can be serviced with reticulated water and electricity seervices and extension of these services would be achieved at a reasonable cost.

There are low lying portions of the land which form anabranches to the Mosquito Depression which lies approximately 5 kms to the west of the subject land. These low lying portions of the land are natural drainage lines and are subject to flooding. However, with an appropriate subdivision pattern, necessary land filling works and the adoption of specific floor levels on certain buildings, the land could be used and developed in an orderly and a proper manner.

The rezoning of the land will offer a viable alternative for the future use and development of the land as the continued agricultural use of the land is untenable.

Explanatory Report—Section 12 (1) (e)
THE DISPLAYING OF SANDWICH BOARD
ADVERTISING SIGNS ON THE
NATURESTRIPS AND FOOTPATHS OF
ROAD RESERVES

Introduction

This is an explanatory report pursuant to the requirements of Section 12 of the Planning and Environment Act in respect of a proposed amendment to the Rodney Planning Scheme.

Victoria Government Gazette

Context of the Proposed Amendment

The proposed amendment arises in the context of requests received by the Responsible Authority from business people in Tatura to allow for the displaying of "Sandwich Board Advertising Signs" on footpaths and nature strips of the Hogan Street Shopping Centre.

Subject Land and the Proposal

Under the Rodney Planning Scheme at present, the displaying of certain Sandwich Board Advertising Signs on footpaths and naturestrips is prohibited. Footpaths and naturestrips constitute part of the road reserve and these road reserves are either reserved as minor roads, main road or highways under the Rodney Planning Scheme. Hogan Street for an example is reserved as a Minor Road under the Planning Scheme whereas McLennan Street, the focal point for Mooroopna's Shopping Centre is reserved as a Highway.

The advertising provision contained in Clauses 60-63 of the Rodney Planning Scheme does allow for the erection and display of some forms of advertising on or over road reserves. "Business Signs", "Identification Signs", "Internally Illuminated Signs" and "Promotion Signs" are some such signs which may be constructed or exhibited.

However, the Planning Scheme Ordinance has been written in such a way that certain Sandwich Board Advertising Signs cannot be allowed due to the type of advertising sign placed on the Sandwich Board, nor can certain Sandwich Board Advertising Signs be interpreted as "Business Signs" or "Identification" due to the class of advertising message displayed by the Sandwich Board Sign.

What the Amendment proposes to do is insert a definition into the Ordinance for Sandwich Board Advertising Signs and require that all such signs be issued a Planning Permit before such signs can be exhibited.

Assessment

Sandwich Board Advertising Signs are an effective form of advertising which is becoming more and more popular with business people. The intention of this Amendment is to recognise the need to allow for such Advertising signs as well as to ensure that the exhibition of such signs is carried out in an orderly and proper way. A number of factors will need to be taken into account when considering planning permit applications. These factors relate to maintaining the streetscape quality of a particular shopping centre, protecting the rural landscape, ensuring the safety of pedestrians and motorists using a footpath or road, and ensuring that such signs do not create a nuisance or annoyance.

It is intended that the Sandwich Board Advertising Signs will only be permitted on the reserved land and land zoned Village, Commercial 'A', Commercial 'B' and Industrial. The exhibiting of such signs will be prohibited in the Rural 'A', Rural 'B', Rural 'C', Residential and Special Uses Zone.
