Subordinate Legislation Act 1962 Conservation, Forests and Lands PROPOSED WILDLIFE (WHALE **WATCHING) REGULATIONS 1990**

A Regulatory Impact Statement has been prepared in relation to the proposed Wildlife (Whale Watching) Regulations 1990.

The principal objective of these regulations is to protect whales from disturbance by persons involved in whale watching activities along Victorian coastal waters.

The reason for the proposed statutory rule is that at present legislation exists in relation to the killing, injuring, harassing and trapping of whales, however, no legislation exists to protect whales from disturbances.

The Regulatory Impact Statement concludes that the proposed regulations are the best means of achieving the stated objectives. The alternative considered, namely self-regulation, was not considered to be appropriate as breaches of the voluntary standards was not enforceable.

Planning and Environment Act 1987 Notice of Approval of Amendment ST. KILDA PLANNING SCHEME Amendment L5


The Minister for Planning and Environment has approved the above amendment.
