No. 13/1990 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), this Act comes into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.

(2) The following provisions are deemed to have come into operation as follows:

(a) Sections 1, 2, 6, 31, 39 (2), 40, 41, 42, 44, 45 and 46 on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent;

(b) Sections 23, 37, 38, 39 (1) and 39 (3) on 9 May 1989.
