Wildlife Act 1975
NOTICE OF CLOSURE OF AREAS
TO HUNTING

I give notice under section 86 of the *Wildlife Act 1975* that—

- (a) the taking, destroying or hunting of any kind or species of wildlife is prohibited—
- (i) in the area described in Schedule 1 during the period described in that Schedule; and
 - (ii) in the area described in Schedule 2 during the period described in that Schedule; and
 - (iii) in the area described in Schedule 3 during the period described in that Schedule; and
 - (iv) in the area described in Schedule 4 during the period described in that Schedule;
- (b) a person who takes, destroys or hunts any kind or species of wildlife in an area specified in Schedule 1, 2, 3 or 4 during the period specified in that Schedule is guilty of an offence and liable to a penalty not exceeding \$200.

Schedule 1

The area known as Alexander Swamp, Shire of Rodney, within the Goulburn River State Forest, known locally as Cooma Bend.

The period beginning on Saturday, 17 March 1990 and ending on Saturday, 14 April 1990.

Schedule 2

The area known as Winters Swamp being Crown Allotment P and Part R, Parish of Dowling Forest, Shire of Ballarat.

The period beginning on Saturday, 17 March 1990 and ending on Thursday, 31 May 1990.

Schedule 3

The area known as Little Lake Buloke which includes all the public land south of the point known as "the Neck" which separates Little Lake Buloke from Lake Buloke, Shire of Donald.

The period beginning on Saturday, 17 March 1990 and ending on Thursday, 31 May 1990.

Schedule 4

The area within 500 metres of the Wool Wool Rocks being the rocks near the shore of that part of Lake Corangamite which forms part of the boundary between the Shires of Colac and Hampden.

The period beginning on Saturday, 17 March 1990 and ending on Thursday, 31 May 1990.
